THE FIRST LOOK

After succumbing to the Assumption Greyhounds for what was the first loss in North-east-10 Conference play this season, New Haven looks to get back in the win column as they welcome the newest affiliate member of the NE10 Post to DellaCamera Stadium. With four teams all sitting at 4-1 in the conference standings the opportunity for a repeat NE10 title is still very much in the mix.

INSIDE THE SERIES

- New Haven and Post meet for the second time in the history of the two programs.
- New Haven won the opening meeting in convincing fashion with a 67-20 final, the most points scored by the Chargers since a 2013 road win over Saint Anselm (70-26).

A WIN OVER POST WOULD...

- return the Charger to the win column after suffering their first NE10 loss last week at Assumption.
- keep the Chargers unbeaten against the Eagles in this just the second meeting between the two squads.

- keep the Chargers as one of four one-loss teams in the NE10 standings.
- be the 288th overall victory in the 45 plus year history of Charger Football.
- be the 258th victory since the Chargers began playing at the Division II level - first DII season was 1982.

GAME DAY FORECAST

An unexpected fall stretch of warm weather continues as the Chargers get back to work on Saturday under good conditions thanks to the warm spell. The forecasted high temperature at kickoff is 60 degrees under sunny skies with a minimal, three percent, chance of precipitation. Additionally, winds will be calm, with any winds coming out of the north-north-west at 11 miles per hour. Sunrise on Saturday is 7:25 p.m. with sunset coming soon after the conclusion of the game at 5:45 p.m.

which has held its last six opponents to less than 100 rushing yards, including a season-low 29 rushing yards against SCSU. Additionally, New Haven racked up a season-high eight sacks against the Owls, as they enter this weekend fifth in all of NCAA Division II in team sacks, averaging 3.57 per game. Leading the Chargers defense is Jalen Fisher with 47 total tackles, while five different players all have two or more total sacks, led by Davon Colon with six. Offensively, New Haven is averaging 33.6 points per game with much of its offensive success coming from its running game which heading into this week against Assumption has galloped for 1,539 yards, averaging 219.9 yards per game. Leading the efforts is senior Christopher Ais (758 total rushing yards) who had a career-high 227 yards at Bentley, marking the first time since the 2015 season a player has run for 200+ yards in a single game. Ais isn't the only back to watch out for as Zaon Laney is just behind him on the year with 544 rushing yards and combined the pair has 10 touchdowns (Ais 7, Laney 3). Under center, New Haven continues to rely on its returning starter, Daelen Menard, who has 1,214 yards and 13 touchdowns on the year, completing 88-of-170 pass attempts. The other highlight for the Chargers has been in the return game where junior Kha'ilil Eason is averaging 38.5 yards per return with three returns of 80+ yards including a pair he returned to the house for touchdowns.

SCOUTING THE EAGLES

Since a season-opening win over West Virginia Wesleyan, the Eagles have not been able to find the win column as they enter today's game with a 1-7 overall record and winless in six NE10 games. For the season, the Eagles are averaging 24.9 points per game however on the flipside they are surrendering 39.1 points on average to their opponents. Offensively, the Eagles have seen two-third of their offense come in the passing game where the average 207.6 yards per game with Malakai Taylor seeing the majority of the action due to an injury to Tyler Phommachanh. Taylor is currently connecting on 46 percent of his attempts (86-of-187) for 1,381 yards and 12 touchdowns. On the ground, Post is led by Isaiah Emmanuel who has 651 of the team's 852 total yards, averaging 81.4 yards per game and 3.7 yards per attempt. Defensively, Michael Gabettie is the outright leader with nearly 30 tackles more than the next closest player as he enters the weekend with 102 stops, including a team-high 5.5 tackles for loss. In the loss column, Zachary Jones followed him with five of his 25 total tackles going for loss, while he also leads

the team with 2.5 sacks.

NEXT ON TAP

For one last time in the regular season, New Haven will embark on a road trip as they head to the Granite State to face the Saint Anselm Hawks, also one of the four teams who enter week nine with a 4-1 NE10 record. Opening kickoff between the Chargers and Hawks is set for 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 9 at Grappone Stadium. All of the action in the conference battle will be available on NE10 Now on Flo College.

NO WAY, NO HOW

Following the Chargers season-opening loss at Slippery Rock, New Haven's defensive line fortified and since then has been a wall of steel, limiting the last six teams to no more than 95 rushing yards, including a season-low 29 yards in the week six win over Southern Connecticut. In the six-game stretch, New Haven has limited teams to an average of just 56.2 rushing yards per game or just 1.9 yards per carry. For the season, New Haven is fifth in NCAA DII for rushing defense with the total average rushing yards per game at 70.3 including the Slippery Rock game.

CAN'T HOLD US BACK

New Haven's defense has been a force to be reckoned since the return to play following the COVID pandemic. The ability for the Chargers to get over the line of scrimmage in record time has been nothing but impressive. Heading into week nine at Assumption, the Chargers are No. 5 in the nation in total sacks, adding two more to the total last week at Assumption. The Chargers preceded that with a season-high eight in week six at SCSU. Overall for the season, New Haven has 25 total sacks for 143 yards with that averaging out to 3.57 per game. Fort Valley State currently leads the nation at 4.00 sacks per game.

GOLDEN CHILDREN

For the first time since the 1997 season, a pair of Chargers have been tabbed NEFW Gold Helmet winners following big time performances on the gridiron. The first to earn the honor was junior return specialist Kha'ilil Eason who secured the distinction following the Pace game where he racked up 231 return yards on four returns for an average of 57.8 yards per return with a pair of touchdowns. The second honor came following the week four win over Bentley University when senior running back Christopher Ais ran for a career-high 227 yards and a pair of touchdowns against the Falcons. The 227 yards for Ais was the first

time a Charger racked up 200+ yards since the 2015 season.

2K CLUB

Senior running back Christopher Ais has been racking up yards since the day he stepped on campus in 2021 and earlier this season became the seventh player in program history to collect at least 2,000 rushing yards. Ais passed the 2K mark with his 120 yards against Pace and took it one step further in the week five win over AIC with his 123 rushing yards pushing him over the 2,500 yard mark. Ais also has a high probability of reaching the No. 2 slot in the all-time record book which is currently held by AJ Livingston (1990-93) who finished his career with 2,904 yards.

COUNT IT ... ONE, TWO, THREE, FOUR

For the first time under head coach Chris Pincince, and the first time since the 1997 season, the New Haven football team racked up 45 points or more in four straight games. In that four-game stretch (weeks 2-5), New Haven averaged 48.3 points per game. The 45+ in the first three games was the first time a New Haven team had scored 45 or more in three-straight since the 2013 season, the final under previous head coach Pete Rossomando. The last time the Chargers scored 40+ in four straight games was in the 1997 season under head coach Tony Sparano wrapping up that year with a 12-2 overall record and an appearance in the NCAA National Championship game.

EVERYTHING COMES IN THREES

With much of New Haven's offense over the past few years coming in its running game, the opportunities for receivers to rack up touchdowns has been fewer, however in the week five win over American International senior wide receiver Mikey Caines finished with three touchdowns, bringing his season total to a team-best eight. The three TD's in a single game for Caines is the first time since the 2018 season when Ju'an Williams finished with three on the road at former NE10 foe Merrimack.

THE CALL OF DUTY

For the past 12 years, the New Haven football team has partnered with Be the Match and the Andy Talley Bone Marrow Foundation's Get In The Game initiative to raise awareness for the need of bone marrow donations in the fight against leukemia, lymphoma and other blood disorders. Over the last 12 years of registry drives the Chargers added than 2,000 people to the registry and have had 10 people match and donate blood marrow to those in need. Recently, a member of the football team, offensive lineman Caleb Beetle, received the call and will be going through the process of donating later this fall.

WE'VE GOT AN EYE ON YOU

Ahead of the 2023 season, the New Haven football team was among teams receiving votes in the preseason AFCA Coaches Poll. Slip-

pery Rock, who the Chargers met in week one, was No. 11 in the coaches poll, while New Haven's eight votes would have placed them 42nd in the poll as they were among 23 total teams receiving votes. Heading into this weekend against Post, New Haven continues to receive votes, while Slippery Rock is slotted 14th.

KEEPING IT CLEAN

Quarterback Daelan Menard had a great eye in his first season slinging passes for the Blue and Gold, allowing just six interceptions on the year. As a team, New Haven had eight total passes intercepted, which was the fewest in the NE10 and ranked 31st in all of NCAA D2. For the season, Menard finished 129-253-6 for 51% and an efficiency rating of 129.4.

ON THE LINE

New Haven's offensive line has always stood up to the test and 2023 was no different as they finished among the top-10 in the nation in a pair of categories. As a unit, the Chargers O-Line surrendered just 39 tackles for loss on the season, with just nine of those being QB sacks. On the national level, the 39 TFL allowed (3.55 per game) was third best in all of NCAA D2, while the nine sacks allowed (0.82 per game) was ninth best in the country.

DEPTH IN THE BACK

The Chargers return a pair of 200+ rushers from last season in senior Christopher Ais and junior Zaon Laney. Ais, who saw action in seven games because of injury, racked up 582 yards and three touchdowns, while Laney finished the year with 247 yards and a team-high average of five yards per carry. Ais is expected to be the first string running back again in 2024 as he looks to build back to his 2022 strength where he closed out the season with 1,105 yards and five TD's. The 1,105 yards for Ais made him just the eighth player in program history to rack up 1,000+ yards.

WAITING FOR HIS MOMENT

New Haven will once again turn to Kha'ilil Eason as the top choice for kick returns. Eason took all but five returns last season, averaging 24.5 yards per return with a season-long of 60 yards which came in the NCAA playoff game against Charleston. Overall, he finished two games with 100+ return yards, while also returning one punt, a blocked punt against Lincoln which he recovered and returned 20 yards for a touchdown.

ON THE LIST

After wrapping up 2023 as an Associated Press Second Team All-American, senior defensive back Giye Jenkins was among the Elite 100 players on the Division II watch list as announced by D2Football.com. Jenkins was the only player from the NE10 to make the cut. The New Jersey native wrapped up 2023 with 57 total tackles including four TFL, while leading the Chargers with five interceptions and eight pass breakups. His 5 INT were the most in the NE10, while he finished the year 13th in NCAA D2 with his 0.5 interceptions per game average.

RETURNING ROYALTY

Seven Chargers will return to the gridiron after racking up postseason honors following the 2023 campaign. Highlighting the group is a pair of major award winners

in senior defensive back Giye Jenkins who was named the Defensive Player of the Year and graduate defensive lineman Jack Quander who was named the Defensive Lineman of the Year. Both were joined on the First Team All-Conference by offensive lineman John Thomas. Additionally, four players who earned Second Team distinction return in 2024; offensive lineman Justin Cesaire, linebackers Devin O'Malley and Joe Vitale and defensive back Christian Ais.

ONE DEGREE ISN'T ENOUGH

With a master's program in sport management, an MBA program and a renowned school of criminal justice it is no wonder so many students call New Haven home when it comes to postgraduate degrees. This season is no different, as 27 Chargers adorn the roster in 2024 after earning an undergraduate degree.

LEADERSHIP QUAD

Following a vote of all eligible players and the coaching staff, University of New Haven Head Football Coach Chris Pincince has named four captains for the 2024 season; Giye Jenkins, John Thomas, Joe Vitale and Jack Quander. The three defensive and one offensive players were among 29 total players to receive at least one vote among the ballots of current players and the coaching staff. Among the 29, nine players received 10 or more votes. Among the four selected, Quander will serve in the role for a second season after he was selected as one of three captains prior to the 2023 season.

FLY EAGLE FLY

After a decorated four-year career in West Haven, tight end Kevin Foelsch embarked on a professional career that included stops at numerous rookie camps last spring and concluded with a preseason invite to the Philadelphia Eagles camp and an eventual spot on the Eagles practice squad ahead of week one. Foelsch concluded his career at New Haven with 73 receptions and 16 touchdowns as his height allowed him to be a big target for quarterbacks Ajee Patterson, Connor Degenhardt and Daelen Menard.

NE10 PARTNERS WITH FLO SPORTS

Prior to the start of the 2024-25 academic year, the Northeast-10 Conference announced a historic multimedia rights agreement with Flo Sports, a global sports media company. The five-year, seven-figure agreement cements the NE10 as a leader in broadcasting at the NCAA Division II level. All NE10 contests and home non-conference games will be aired live on the Flo Sports platform. Fans can purchase a monthly or yearly subscription which will allow users to

watch content across six Division II conferences that partner with Flo Sports.

PRESEASON PROPS

For the fifth straight season, the New Haven football team will enter the year as the team to beat according to a poll of the Northeast-10 Conference's eight head coaches. New Haven racked up a total of 64 points and eight of the nine possible first place votes to finish as the unanimous choice to win the league title. The Chargers finished nine points ahead of Bentley, while the Assumption Greyhounds were 16 points back while also garnering the final first place tally.
