THE FIRST LOOK

A second-straight week on the road and a second-straight week under the lights for the Chargers as they head to the Bay State for the second time this season, this time heading to Springfield to take on the AIC Yellow Jackets. The Chargers look to remain undefeated in NE10 play while also having AIC its third loss in as many league games.

INSIDE THE SERIES

- New Haven and American International meet for the 29th time in the history of the two programs.
- Overall, the Chargers hold a 21-7 record over the previous 28 meetings, with the all-time series dating back to 1983.
- In the 14 meetings since 2009, the Chargers hold an 13-1 record, including victories in the last eight meetings.
- Prior to restarting the series in 2009, New Haven and AIC had not met since 1996.
- In most recent memory, New Haven has not lost to AIC under head coach Chris Pincince, currently riding an eight-game

win streak.

A WIN OVER AMERICAN INT'L WOULD...

- keep the Chargers undefeated, 9-0, against AIC under head coach Chris Pincince.
- keep New Haven undefeated in NE10 play with Bentley and Saint Anselm also currently undefeated at 1-0, while Assumption has yet to play an NE10 game.
- be the 278th overall victory in the 44 plus year history of Charger Football.
- be the 248th victory since the Chargers began playing at the Division II level - first DII season was 1982.

GAME DAY FORECAST

For the second straight week, New Haven will take the field under wet conditions with a 77% chance of rain predicted for Friday night in Springfield. The high temperature for the day will be 61 degrees with a low after dark of 51 degrees. BY THE NUMBERS

1 For the fourth straight season, New Haven entered the season as the preseason No. 1 pick to win the Northeast-10 Conference title in a poll of the league's head coach.

2 New Haven is currently No. 2 in all of NCAA Division II with its 10 total interceptions on the season after adding four against Franklin Pierce last weekend.

9 Another top-10 ranking for the Chargers this time around in total tackles for loss allowed with an average of 3.5 per game which leads the NE10 and is ninth in the country.

34 New Haven has always been a hot bed for graduate students looking to continue their education and play the extent of their eligibility. This season is no different as the Chargers boast 34 grad students on the active roster.

50 Years since the inception of football at the University of New Haven, while 2023 marks the 45th season the Chargers will take the field. The inaugural season was in 1973 at the Division III level, with the Chargers making the transition to D2 in 1982.

SCOUTING THE CHARGERS

Since opening up conference play, the Chargers have outscoring their opponents by 27 points per game and taken advantage of the six interceptions they have caused by scoring 28 points off of those turnovers. In addition, when playing on the road, the Chargers are outscoring their opponents by 14 points per game. Back to conference only contests, New Haven has scored nine of their 13 total touchdowns in the two lead games, with seven coming thanks to the hand of Daelen Menard who is 33-of-51 (65%) without an interception. Overall for the year, Menard is 53-of-122 with 728 yards with 10 total TDs, while he has also added a pair of rushing touchdowns. On the ground, the Chargers will rely on Hunter Cobb and Zaon Laney again this week, with the pair combining for 225 rushing yards and Cobb adding the only other rushing TD. Downfield, Menard has relied on a plethora of players with 12 different players all hauling in at least one catch, led by graduate tight end Kevin Foelsch with 12 catches for 157 yards and four touchdowns. Defensively, Giye Jenkins currently leads the team with 22 tackles while he has also picked off three of the team's 10 total interceptions, returning one for a touchdown. The Chargers 10 INTs on the year currently has them ranked second in the nation, behind Emporia State who has 11.

SCOUTING THE YELLOW JACKETS

A team searching for just its second win and its first conference win, American International has seen the majoring of its 13.8 points per game scoring come at the start and end of a game with 42 of their 55 total points split equally among the first and fourth quarters. As a team, the Yellow Jackets are averaging 73.5 rushing yards per game and 194 passing yards per game, while being outperformed by more than 100 yards per game in total offense. Grad QB Cephas Williams leads the offense with 776 passing yards, connecting on just 48% of his attempts with six touchdowns. On the ground, JR RB Sidiki Kone has done the majority of the work with 238 of the 294 total yards. Defensively, graduate linebacker Marcus Thomas

leads the team with 28 tackles while junior linebacker Tyson Thornton and sophomore linebacker Chris Chasia each lead the way with 3.5 tackles for loss.

NEXT ON TAP

The Chargers will spend the whole month of October in West Haven, not returning to the road until November 4. That homestand will consist of three games and include the bye week. First up will be back-to-back game weekends as the Chargers welcome a first time opponent in Lincoln for Family Day and Saint Anselm for Homecoming weekend. First up will be Lincoln on Saturday, October 7 as the University celebrates Family Day. Kickoff is slated 1:00 p.m., with all of the action available live on NE10NOW.TV.

DYNAMIC DUO

Three straight weeks, three straight awards for the New Haven football team, this time around as a pair of Chargers garnered Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week honors from the Northeast-10. Offensively it was transfer quarterback Daelen Menard whose 258 yards, four touchdown performance at Franklin Pierce earned the distinction. On the other side of the ball it was Devin O'Malley's 80-yard interception TD leading to his first collegiate honor. In addition to the INT, O'Malley finished with five tackles, including one for loss, a pass breakup and a QB hurry.

HONOR ROLL SQUARED

For the second straight week, JR DB Giye Jenkins has taken home the NE10's Defensive Player of the Week, once again adding an interception to go along with his game-high 10 tackles against the crosstown rival Owls. For the season, Jenkins has now picked off on pass in all three games and is tied for second in the country in INT per game. With his 10 tackles he also vaulted himself into the number two slot on the team with 19 tackles.

WE'VE GOT AN EYE ON YOU

Ahead of the 2023 season, D2Football.com released its annual Division II Elite 100 Watch List and the Chargers Dev Holmes is among those to keep an eye on in 2023, one of eight wide receivers to make the cut. A First Team All-Confer-

ence and All-New England choice last season, Holmes Led the team and the Northeast-10 Conference in total yards with 825 which came on 40 receptions for an average of 20.6 yards per catch and 75.0 yards per game. He also led all league receivers with nine touchdowns, three more than any other player. His 825 yards and 75 ypg ranked him 36th best in all of NCAA Division II, while his 20.62 yards per catch was the 14th best in the nation.

20/20 VISION

The Chargers defense has proven there is no need to bring in an optimologist as they are seeing the ball with 20/20 vision, picking off 10 passes on the year which is currently the second most in all of NCAA Division II behind just Emporia State who has 11 INTs. Leading the way is JR DB Giye Jenkins who has three interceptions, one in each of the first three games of the year, retuning one of those for a TD. Overall, three of the 10 INTs have been returned for touchdowns with Jalen Fisher (30 yards) and Devin O'Malley (80 yards) each returning one to the house. O'Malley's 80 yard return was one of a season-high four TD's in the road win at Franklin Pierce.

LEAVE IT ALL ON THE LINE

The offensive line has always been a key piece of the equation for the Chargers and 2023 should prove to be no different. Four of the Chargers five starters on the O-Line are returning, including graduate right guard Xavier Bryson and sophomore left tackle who are both coming off of NE10 All-Conference honors last season. As a unit in 2022, the Chargers O-Line led the offense to an average of 34.5 points per game, and a total offense (380.7 yards pe game) that was top-60 in the nation. In addition, the Chargers were eighth in the nation for fewest interceptions allowed with just five total on the year, while the Chargers rushing offense was once again in the top-50

at 171.0 yards per game. So far this season, the O-Line hasn't let up and to their credit, the Chargers are currently ninth in the nation in tackles for loss allowed, surrendering just 3.5 per game. South Dakota School of Mines currently leads the nation at 2.25 TFL allowed per game.

BEAT THE FLASH

Junior running back Christopher Ais returns to the backfield after one of the most successful seasons in recent memory, racking up 1,105 rushing yards which makes him just the eighth player in school history to run for 1,000+ yards in a single season. The Stoughton, Mass. native earned First Team All-Conference after leading all NE10 backs on the ground. For the season, Ais averaged 100.5 yards per game, 5.8 yards per carry and led

the Chargers run game with seven touchdowns.

ON THE LINE

Entering 2023, the Chargers have won 18-straight home games against another NE10 team, regular or postseason. Last year the Chargers were 4-0 at home against an NE10 opponent, while in 2021 they were 6-0 with two of those wins against Bentley. The most recent loss at home against an NE10 team came on November 11, 2017, the final game of the season, a 31-21 loss to Merrimack who is one of two teams to have left the conference in recent years. With a win over SCSU so far this season, that streak now stands at 19 straight home wins over a conference opponent.

RETURNING ROYALTY

Seven Chargers returned to the gridiron after racking up postseason honors after the 2022 campaign. Highlighting the group is junior running back Christopher Ais who in addition to earning First Team All-NE10 was an All-New England and All-Super Region 1 selection. Joining him on the All-New England roster was graduate receiver Dev Holmes. In addition to Ais and Holmes, four additional players were NE10 First Team Selections - tight end Kevin Foelsch, offensive lineman Xavier Bryson, defensive lineman Jack Quander and defensive back Damon Burton, Jr. Rounding out the returning award winners is offensive lineman Justin Cesaire who earned a spot on the All-Rookie squad.

ONE DEGREE ISN'T ENOUGH

With a master's program in sport management, an MBA program and a renowned school of criminal justice it is no wonder so many students call New Haven home when it comes to postgraduate degrees. This season is no different, as 35 Chargers who have already earned an undergraduate degree are among the active roster for this weekend, while there are 36 total players on the roster who are pursuing a postgraduate degree. With the recent release from the National Football Foundation, the Chargers are officially No. 1 in the nation with its 36 graduate student-athletes among the 2,949 total players across all divisions who are playing this season with an undergrad degree already secured.

ON THE RADAR

Following a third appearance, in the last four seasons, in the NCAA Division II playoffs last year, the Chargers are garnering attention right out of the gates as one of 38 teams listed among those receiving votes in the preseason coaches poll presented by the American Football Coaches Association. The AFCA poll is voted on by select coaches representing each of Division II's eight Super Regions and is updated weekly.

LEADERSHIP TRIO

Following the Chargers three-week preseason, head coach Chris Pincince announced a trio of players that will make up the leadership corps for 2023; defensive

lineman Jack Quander, wide receiver Dev Holmes and tight end Kevin Foelsch. All three played incredibly important roles last season and will be looked on to continue that success while also leading the next generation of Chargers to another NE10 Championship and deep run into the postseason.

THE SCHEDULE

The New Haven football team will play six home games as part of a 10-game schedule in 2023. Included in that slate are three non-conference games, the first also the first ever game under the lights at Ralph F. DellaCamera Stadium as the Chargers host Frostburg for a rare Thursday night match-up. Following that will be the first of two meetings against conference foe Bentley, with the first serving as a non-conference match-up. Finally, the Chargers will welcome another newbie to the D2 scene in Lincoln University (Calif.) to West Haven to start the month of October. The seven-game Northeast-10 Conference schedule will kick off with the annual Battle for the Elm City against Crosstown rival Southern Connecticut State University and will be the first time on the year that the Charger look to defend a home-turf streak that includes 18-straight wins against a conference opponent. NCAA postseason play kicks off on November 18 with the top seven teams in Super Region 1 battling for a spot in the national semifinals.

PRESEASON PROPS

For the fourth straight season, the New Haven football team will enter the year as the team to beat according to a poll of the Northeast-10 Conference's eight head coaches. New Haven racked up a total of 48 points and six of the eight possible first place votes in the poll, finishing five points ahead of the Assumption Greyhounds who garnered the two remaining first place votes after earning the league title last season with a head-to-head win over the Chargers.

NCAA Division I level. In eight seasons leading the Chargers, Pincince has collected 60 wins passing Mark Whipple as the all-time winningest coach in the storied history of the program, while leading the Blue and Gold to the NCAA Championship in three of the last four seasons and advancing to the Second Round in two of those appearances (2018 & 2021). Overall in eight seasons, 13 players have received All-American accolades while offensive lineman Zach Voytek was a three-time NE10 Offensive Lineman of the Year and signed as an undrafted free agent with the Buffalo Bills. Additionally, 59 different players have been named All-Conference, while 12 have garnered All-Region honors. This past season, Pincince led the Blue and Gold to an 8-3 overall record (6-1 in the NE10) and its second-straight appearance in the NCAA playoffs and third in the last four seasons. Highlighting the individual accolades was graduate quarterback Connor Degenhardt who was named the NE10's Offensive Player of the Year, one of 14 players to earn postseason honors from the league office. In addition to Degenhardt, 11 players earned First Team All-Conference distinction, the most among any conference team, with seven on offense and five on defense. Beyond Degenhardt's major conference honor, the Chargers had three players (RB Christopher Ais, WR Dev Holmes, RS Terrell Ford) earn All-New England status from the New England Football Writers Association and a trio pick up D2CCA All-Region distinction; Ais, OL William Ayers and LB David Onyemem. Rounding out all the postseason honors was Ford who picked up American Football Coaches Association All-America honors as a return specialist after picking off a pair of individual game records with 229 kick return yards against American International and a record 100-yard kickoff return against Franklin Pierce. After missing the 2020 season due to the CoVID-19 shutdown, the Chargers finished the 2021 campaign 10-2 overall, including an undefeated 8-0 record in Northeast-10 Conference play, securing the first NE10 Conference Championship since the 2012 season and earning the program's eighth trip to the NCAA Division II Championship. The Blue and Gold went on to defeat Bentley in the opening round of the national tournament, advancing to the regional semifinals for the second time in as many appearances. In addition to Pincince earning NE10 Coach of the Year accolades, he was also named the New England Football Writers Coach of the Year while graduate offensive lineman Mike Zecchin joined him with a major award as he was tabbed the NE10's Offensive Lineman of the Year. After finishing among the best defensive programs in the country, the Chargers were highlighted by junior defensive back Khyon Fitzpatrick who was named a second team All-American by the American Football Coaches of America. Overall, Fitzpatrick and Zecchin were part of 14 players who earned NE10 All-Conference honors while as a team, the Chargers finished 2021 ranked No.14 in the AFCA Coaches Poll. The Chargers closed out the 2019 season finished tied with Bentley with a 6-2 record in Northeast-10 Conference play. Among the highlights for Pincince's squad was Shamar Logan garnering NE10 Rookie of the Year accolades as he was one of 16 Chargers to earn NE10 postseason distinction. Logan would go on to earn All-Region honors along with Markel Johnson and Ju'an Williams, the latter of which was named the regions Special Teams Player of the Year. In 2018, Pincince coached a pair of record breakers in quarterback Ajee Patterson and Williams. Patterson graduated as arguably the best quarterback in New Haven history, the first to throw for more than 10,000 yards while racking up 80 touchdowns, second most in program history. The NE10 MVP and First Team All-Conference selection, Patterson closed out his collegiate campaign with a career-high 2,878 yards and 29 touchdowns, leading his squad to the NCAA Championship for the first time since 2012. Williams, a Don Hanson Honorable Mention All-American, registered a single season school record 1,171 receiving yards which came on 65 catches while completing 11 for touchdowns. Joining Williams in earning All-American accolades was Dan Iannone who anchored an offensive line that contributed to 4,827 total yards on offense, the most in the NE10, which included just shy of 2,000 yards rushing. In addition, the O-Line protection was impeccable, allowing Patterson to be sacked just three times through the 10-game regular season. Voytek was one of two Chargers named All-American in 2016, joining linebacker Tyler Condit. Together, the pair were part of nine total players who received NE10 All-Conference honors following a 7-4 season that included

a pair of wins over crosstown rival Southern Connecticut State University, representing eight straight season New Haven has maintained the Elm City Trophy. On the field, Condit set a pair of records, becoming the all-time leading tackler at New Haven as well as in the Northeast-10. He finished his collegiate career with 117 tackles as a senior, becoming just the second player in school history to finish with at least 100 stops in three seasons. In just his second season leading the Chargers, Pincince led the Blue and Gold to the N10 Championship game, finishing the year with a 7-4 record. Among the highlights were a pair of record setting performances from junior running back Andre Anderson and Condit. Anderson broke a 22 year old record set by Roger Graham when he rushed for 319 yards in the regular season finale against Saint Anselm. In that same game, Condit shattered a 29 year old record when he finished with 25 tackles, giving him 153 for the season, which surpassed the previous record of 134 by Erik Lesinski. Anderson and Condit were two of four Chargers who received NE10 Player of the Year accolades at their respective positions, with Anderson earning Most Valuable Player accolades. In his first season strolling the sideline at New Haven, Pincince led the Chargers to a 6-5 overall record, including a string of six straight victories in Northeast-10 Conference action. Among the highlights from Pincince's first season was Condit who was named a USA College Football All-America Honorable Mention. A pair of Chargers were also honored among the major awards from the Northeast-10 Conference with Voytek named co-Offensive Lineman of the Year and freshman running back Lemar Thomas named Rookie of the Year. In total, 10 players were named to NE10 All-Conference squads. With two previous stints as an assistant at New Haven, Pincince began his career with the Chargers in 1995 as an assistant for UNH Athletics Hall of Famer and current Minnesota Vikings offensive line coach Tony Sparano. He spent three additional seasons with the Chargers from 1999 to 2001 under Darren Rizzi, current Assistant Head Coach and special teams' coordinator for the Miami Dolphins. Prior to his most recent position as offensive coordinator at NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) member Elon University in North Carolina, Pincince was the offensive coordinator at the University of Rhode Island and the College of the Holy Cross. At Elon, Pincince was the offensive coordinator as well as the quarterbacks and running backs coach for three seasons. In his first year Elon's offense led the Southern Conference and ranked 14th nationally with 281 passing yards per game. Pincince's offensive scheme was anchored by All-America wide receiver Aaron Mellette, who led all of FCS in receptions per game (10.27) and receiving yards per game (149). His season totals also set new school and conference records in 2011. Quarterback Thomas Wilson also led the conference and ranked 14th nationally in total offense. In his second season at Elon, the offense ranked 12th in the FCS in passing yards per game (296), with Mellette again earning All-America honors. The receiver became the first Elon player invited to the Senior Bowl and was later selected in the seventh round of the NFL draft by the Baltimore Ravens. In Pincince's final season at Elon, the Phoenix ranked second in the conference in passing yards per game (231) and averaged over 350 total yards per contest. During the three seasons prior to arriving at Elon, Pincince was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at the University of Rhode Island. While at URI, Pincince installed the spread offense, and the Rams ranked fifth in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) in passing offense in his first season. Pincince also spent four years at the College of the Holy Cross, including two seasons as the Crusaders' offensive coordinator. In 2007, the Holy Cross offense led the Patriot League in scoring (35.9 ppg), passing (335 ypg), total offense (463 ypg) and first downs (272). Crusaders quarterback Dominic Randolph led the league in passing (3,604 yards), touchdown passes (30) and total offense (340 ypg) and finished 12th in the balloting for the Walter Payton Award. Pincince's first two seasons at Holy Cross were spent as the wide receivers coach. Prior to his tenure at Holy Cross, Pincince served as the offensive coordinator at Ursinus College in 2003. The season before, Pincince was the quarterbacks coach at Brown University. He also spent two seasons at Fairfield University. During his five previous seasons at New Haven, the Chargers combined for a 32-18-1 record and advanced to the NCAA Division II quarterfinal round in 1995. The Chargers finished the regular season undefeated and earned a 27-12 victory over Edinboro in the opening round of the NCAA playoffs. In his second stint, the Chargers averaged over 30 points and 350 yards per game during his three-season stretch. A native of Woonsocket, R.I., Pincince earned his bachelor's degree from Boston University in 1994. He was a member of the Terriers' 1993 Yankee Conference Championship team and played on two NCAA Division I-AA (now FCS) playoff teams. He and his wife, Jennifer, have two sons, Zachary and Owen, and a daughter, Emma.
