OPENING TIP

The New Haven women's basketball team will look to make it two wins in a row to start the season this Saturday night when in-state rival Bridgeport will make the short trip up I-95 to Charger Gymnasium for a 6:30 p.m. tip.

The 45th season of New Haven women's basketball got off to a solid start last Saturday with the Chargers 68-57 win over the College of Staten Island.

Saturday's game is the second of a fourgame homestand to open the season for the Blue and Gold.

INSIDE THE SERIES

- The Chargers have bested the Purple Knights in each of their last six matchups, dating back to 2006 when they were both members of the East Coast Conference.
- New Haven is 36-28 all-time against Bridgeport dating back to their first matchup in 1977.

SCOUTING NEW HAVEN

- After a sluggish start in the first half of last Saturday's season-opener against Staten Island, the Chargers cranked up the volume in the second half, outscoring CSI 36-21, including 24-7 in the third quarter to claim a 68-57 win.
- Freshman Aurora Deshaies led all scorers with 20 points and added six rebounds on 8-of-12 shooting to earn Northeast-10 Rookie of the Week hon-
- The Chargers had nine different players score at least two points in the game. Micah Wormack (13) and Camryn DeBose (10) each scored in double figures while DeBose chipped in a teamleading nine rebounds.

- Brie Pergola had a career night with career-highs of eight rebounds and six steals. She also tied her career-high mark with six assists. She also chipped in eight points.
- Bionca Chambers made her Charger debut with nine points on 3-of-5 shooting and three steals off the bench.
- The Chargers were selected to finish third in the Southwest Division in this year's Northeast-10 Preseason Coaches Poll. New Haven returns four players that started in at least 17 games last season.

Reigning NE10 All-Rookie selection Camryn DeBose was one of two all-conference honorees for the Chargers last season, a freshman campaign that saw her start all 30 games at guard and average 9.2 points and 4.3 rebounds per game. She also led the team from beyond the arc where she shot 33.6 percent. She dished out 39 assists and was second on the team with 62 steals.

Forward Micah Wormack returns for her senior season after ranking fifth in the NE10 last season with a team-high .527 field goal pct. She was second on the team in both points per game (12.2) and rebounds per game (7.8). She had a career-game with 30 points and 18 rebounds at Pace on February 13, shooting 14-for-22 from the field.

Junior point guard Brie Pergola started all 30 games last season, scoring at a 7.8 ppg clip, while dishing out 79 assists (2.6 apg), which ranked second on the team. She connected on 36.7 percent of her shots from the floor and added 28 total steals. She reached double-figures in scoring on eight occasions and was first on the squad from the free throw line, where she held a .771 percentage.





BRIDGEPORT

The Chargers also return senior Kim Talley, who made 17 starts at forward last season. She averaged 3.0 points and 3.8 rebounds per game while shooting 40.4 percent from the floor.

The Chargers started last season 5-2 through the end of November. They went on to rattle off seven straight wins from Dec. 11 through January 16. The Chargers won their final three regular season NE10 matchups, including a 55-50 win over eventual NE10 Tournament champion Le Moyne in the regular season finale. The Chargers earned the Southwest Division's No. 3 seed in the NE10 Tournament and pulled off a 58-52 overtime upset at No. 2 seed Stonehill in the NE10 quarterfinals, advancing to the semifinals for the first time since 2016.

SCOUTING BRIDGEPORT

- The preseason No. 5 pick in the East Coast Conference, UB has opened up the season with a pair of double-digit losses to Southern Conn. State and Saint Anselm, both at home.
- The Knights were outscored 19-4 in the fourth quarter of their 71-55 season-opening loss to SCSU. Against Saint Anselm, it was the middle two quarters that doomed UB, when they were outscored by a combined total of 53-29.
- Five different Purple Knights have reached double figures through the first two games with senior Jaqualah Holliman, junior Kyle Felton and sophomore Gianna Gotti each scoring 10 points against Saint Anselm, while juniors Alyzae Davis (15) and Samirah Henderson (13) both reached double figures against SCSU.
- In total, UB is scoring 61.5 ppg this season, while allowing 82.0 for a scoring margin of -20.5. The team is shooting 35.8 percent from the field and 29.7 percent from the arc.
- Davis is the lone UB player averaging double figures through the first two games with 11.5 ppg, followed by Henderson (8.5 ppg) and Loney (7.5 ppg). Holliman (5.5 rpg) is the team's leader on the glass.

LAST TIME THEY MET

New Haven took down Bridgeport in last year's season opener, 64-31 down in the Park City. The win marked the sixth straight victory for New Haven over the Purple Knights, dating back over a decade.

DeBose and Wormack had big games to lead New Haven. DeBose finished off what was her collegiate debut with 19 points and eight rebounds, while Wormack added 17 points and eight boards.

NEXT ON TAP

New Haven will continue its four-game homes-

tand to open the season this Wednesday, Nov. 20 against Bloomfield at 7 p.m.

LAST TIME OUT

- New Haven shot 43.5 percent from the floor and dished out 18 assists on 27 made baskets in their 68-57 win over Staten Island.
- The Chargers received quality minutes from up and down its lineup, with nine players registering at least 10 minutes of play, and the bench accounting for 33 of the team's points.
- Defensively, New Haven held the Dolphins to 28.0 percent shooting overall, including just a 5-for-25 clip in the second half. The win marks the third season in a row the Chargers have emerged victorious in the season opener.
- Trailing by three at halftime, New Haven started the second half on an 11-2 run.
- After the Dolphins got within five, New Haven put the game away with an extended 12-0 run to make it 55-40, then added an 8-0 run early in the fourth to build a 20-point lead.
- CSI scored 13 of the game's final 17 points.

AN IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Freshman Aurora Deshaies made quite the splash in her collegiate debut last Saturday, scoring 20 points on 8-of-12 shooting and adding six rebounds and one steal. Her efforts earned her the NE10 Rookie of the Week selection, the first Charger to earn the honor since 2017-18 when teammate Brie Pergola earned the honor three different times.

PERGOLA'S CAREER NIGHT

Junior guard Brie Pergola put forth a career night against Staten Island, setting new careerhighs with eight rebounds and six steals, and tied her career-high with six assists. She also chipped in eight points.

Her previous career-highs were six rebounds, which she accomplished twice, and four steals (12/8/18 at Le Moyne). She has now reached six assists on three separate occasions.

PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

Senior Micah Wormack finished last year ranked fifth in the NE10 in field goal pct. (.527), the ninth-highest single season percentage in program history. In Saturday's season opener, she shot just under 50 percent (6-for-13/.462) from the field to score 13 points.

GOING GOING GONE...

New Haven will need to replace the void left by graduated senior Alexandria Kerr, who led the team in scoring each of the last two seasons. Last year, she ranked ninth in the NE10 with a team-high 15.8 ppg and was eighth with

8.4 rpg. She led the conference in steals per game, finishing with 91 total thefts, and led the Chargers with 83 assists. A First Team All-NE10 honoree last season, Kerr finished her career ninth on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,500 career points, eighth all-time with 814 rebounds and sixth with 346 career free throws. Her efforts on the court and in the classroom landed her on the CoSIDA Academic All-District First Team each of the last three seasons.

FRESH FACES

The Chargers welcome seven newcomers to this year's squad, including two transfers and five incoming freshmen.

- #15 Jasmine White - Forward

The junior comes to New Haven after two years at Division I La Salle where she averaged 1.5 ppg and 2.4 rpg over 27 games last season.

- #5 Bionca Chambers - Guard

Chambers joins New Haven from Felician University where she was named Third Team All-CACC last season. The junior forward was also named to the Metropolitan Basketball Writer's Association Second Team.

- #2 Brianna Diaz - Guard

Played three years of varsity basketball at Cardinal Spellman High School, helping to lead the team to the CHSAA state title in 2019 and a division title in 2018.

- #3 Aliyah Wright - Guard

Wright was a five-year varsity team member at Colonie Central High School. She graduated as the all-time leading scorer in program history, collecting over 1,000 points. She was a two-time section all-star and the 2018 Section 2 Most Valuable Player.

- #21 Kameryn King - Guard

The 2019 Hartford Courant Player of the Year, King was a CHSCA All-State and Academic All-State selection in 2019. She was named to the USA Today All-USA CT Girls Basketball Team in 2019, and helped Mercy High School to a Class LL state title in and the No. 1 ranking in Connecticut as a junior in 2017-18. She finished her career with 1,007 points.

- #34 Aurora Deshaies - Forward

The 2019 Liberty Central Conference Player of the Year and a 2018 third team all-state honoree, Deshaies led Bishop Ludden to the Section 3 championship title in 2017 and 2018. She scored over 1,000 points in her career and was a four-year member of the volleyball team.

- #44 Alyssa Stevenson - Forward

A three-time Frontier League and NY State Section 3 All-Star, Stevenson helped lead South Jefferson Central to the NY State Section 3 Championship title her senior year. She was also a three-year member of the tennis and lacrosse teams.

KEEPNG IT CLOSE

New Haven was 4-0 last season in games decided by five points or less.

BREAKTHROUGH WHEN IT MATTERED

New Haven's win at Stonehill in the NE10 quarterfinals was the team's first win this season when trailing with five minutes left in regulation (1-12 last season).

LESS MEANS MORE WINS

New Haven was 6-1 when holding their opponents to under 50 points last season, and 16-2 when allowing less than 60 points.

coach in 2019-20. In her first season on the Charger sidelines in 2018-19, Buff led New Haven to a six-win improvement over the previous season, piloting the team to an 18-12 record and the semifinal round of the Northeast-10 Conference Tournament.

Buff also helped mentor Alexandria Kerr, a First Team All-NE10 honoree and three-time CoSIDA First Team Academic All-District selection, along with NE10 All-Rookie selection Camryn DeBose.

Buff came to West Haven following a seven-year stint at Wheeling Jesuit University, where she led the Cardinals to back-to-back Mountain East Conference Championships and Division II tournament appearances. Buff is no stranger to the NE10 having served as an Assistant Coach with the Saint Rose Golden Knights where she helped lead Saint Rose to the 2000 NCAA Division II Northeast Region Championship, a 34-1 record and a national ranking as high as No. 1 in the country.

Along with Buff, two additional coaches joined the New Haven sideline for the first time in 2018-19; assistant coach Steve Bower and graduate assistant Michelle Brandao.

SMART, NOT JUST ON THE COURT

In addition to earning all-rookie honors for her play on the court, Camryn DeBose also was recognized for her success off the court by earning a 4.0 GPA during the spring semester. She was named to the NE10's Academic Honor Roll, and one of only 11 Chargers department-wide to earn Academic Excellence accolades from the conference.

STORIED HISTORY

The women's basketball program at New Haven has a very strong history. The Chargers brought home the 1987 national championship title when they defeated Cal-Poly Pomona 77-75 to lift the trophy. Overall, New Haven has advanced to the national tournament nine times, most recently in back-to-back seasons in 2014 and 2015. The latter of those two seasons saw the Chargers advance to the Elite Eight for just the second time in program history after defeating Stonehill 58-57 to win the East Region Championship.

Debbie Buff enters her second season with the University of New Haven women's basketball team in the 2019-20 academic year. Buff comes to West Haven following a seven-year stint at Wheeling Jesuit University (Wheeling, W.V.) which included back-to-back Mountain East Conference Championships and NCAA Division II tournament appearances.

In her first season with the Chargers in 2018-19, Buff helped lead New Haven to an 18-12 record, an improvement of six wins over the season prior to her arrival. The season culminated with at trip to the NE10 semifinals for the first time since 2016 following a road victory over Stonehill in the NE10 quarterfinals. Buff also helped mentor Alexandria Kerr, a First Team All-NE10 honoree and three-time CoSIDA First Team Academic All-District selection.

Buff took over the Wheeling Jesuit program in 2011 and in five years led her first full recruiting class to the first of back-to-back Mountain East Conference Championships in 2015-16. The Cardinals finished that season with a 27-6 overall record, which tied the school record for most victories in a single season.

The Cardinals followed that up with a second-straight 25-win season, Mountain East Championship and subsequent trip to the NCAA Division II regional championship. Over her seven years in West Virginia, Buff collected a 111-93 overall record for a .544 winning percentage. Over her seven years, the Cardinals finished with a plus-.500 record on four

Prior to Wheeling Jesuit, Buff spent two seasons at Endicott College where she led the Gulls to the most wins in school history with a 23-6 record in 2008-09 and an appearance in the championship game of the Commonwealth Coast Conference. In her two seasons at Endicott, she compiled an overall record of 42-14.

Her first stint as a head coach came at the Rochester Institute of Technology where her five-plus year career was highlighted by Empire 8 Coach of the Year accolades in 2006-07 when she led the Tigers to the most victories in the history of the RIT women's basketball program and the program's first ever appearance in the Empire 8 and ECAC Championships.

Prior to her collegiate head coaching career, Buff served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at fellow Northeast-10 opponent College of Saint Rose where she helped lead the Golden Knights to the 2000 NCAA Division II Northeast Region Championship, a 34-1 record and a national ranking as high as No. 1 in the country.

Previous to joining a college program, Buff spent 14 years as the head coach at Bishop Maginn High School in Albany. In her time there, she recorded 203 wins and 57 losses while capturing five Big 10 Conference Championships, a Section II title, a regional title and a New York State Class A title. A Hall of Famer at Bishop Maginn, Buff was named the New York State Coach of the Year following the team's 1996 state title run.

A graduate from the State University of New York College at Cortland with a Bachelor of Science degree in physical education, she also holds a Master's Degree in health education from Russell Sage College. During her time at Cortland, she competed three years for the women's basketball team before turning her attention to training for the Skylon International Marathon in New York.
