

HEAD COACH COLLEEN O'HARA



Colleen O'Hara comes to UNH following a stellar playing career at Penn State University, where she earned All-American and All-Region honors in both 2003 and 2002. A four-year letter-winner, she led the Nittany Lions in scoring for three straight seasons with 52 points on 33 goals as a sophomore, 59 points on 46

goals as a junior and 57 points on 34 goals as a senior. In her fouryear career, Colleen scored 132 total goals and had 76 assists for

208 points in 69 games played.

A graduate of Pennsylvania State University, Colleen served an internship at Lock Haven University in the Fall of 2003 where she helped train and prepare the women's lacrosse team for their upcoming season. She also assisted with the day-to-day operations of the athletic department.



ALAN MACDOUGALL ASSISTANT COACH

Coach MacDougall enters his fourth season as an assistant coach for the women's lacrosse team. The 1988 University of Rochester graduate served as an assistant

women's lacrosse coach for the Yellowjackets for three years before moving to the New Haven area. He spent three seasons as the head coach of the Hamden High School club program. He currently runs competitively for the Hi-Tek Racing Club in the submasters category and serves as one of the four team captains while training for various triathalons including Ironman. In addition to his coaching duties, he also serves as the team's strength and conditioning coach.





Jessica Clow-Senior Newington, CT-Captain

Clow returns for her senior year as one of the high scorers from the past two seasons totaling 44 goals and 12 assists. Last year she finished second on the team with 16 goals and 7 assists. This year she looks to step right back into the attacking end and be the offensive force she has been for the past three seasons. The 2004 University of New Haven women's lacrosse team returns ten players from last season's team that posted a 6-7 record in the its third year as a varsity program. This year's team will look to improve on that mark get over the .500 mark for the first time in the program's four-year history.

The 2004 Chargers welcome first-year head coach Colleen O'Hara, who comes to West Haven after a stellar playing career at Penn State University.

Leading the attack for UNH will be seniors Jessica Clow and Stephanie Napp. Also helping New Haven on offense will be junior Sandy Schmidt, sophomore Britt Tregear and freshmen Heather Miles and Maggi Mead. Clow, Napp, and Tregear finished last season with a combined 50 goals and 16 assists. Napp leads the trio goal-scoring with 16.

UNH will look to get strong leadership from its 2004 captains seniors Lindsay Matteo and Jess Clow, plus junior Eileen Perchinski.

Backboning the defense will be junior Eileen Perchinski, Jamie Metcalf and Jodi Albert who is making the transition from attack. Freshman Jenny Griffin will help complete the defensive unit. Perchinski comes off an amazing sophomore season as the leading defensive player with 46 caused turnovers. She also collected a team high 34 ground balls. Goalkeepers Heather Gebhardt and Kelly Stratton will be fighting for the starting position taking the reigns of former Chargers goalie Lisa Simpson.

Top newcomers include freshmen Maggi Mead, Heather Miles, and Jenny Griffin, who should quickly contribute to the Chargers success on the field.
