

HEAD COACH HEATHER McCLELLAND

Heather McClelland enters her first season as the Chargers' head women's lacrosse coach. McClelland comes to New Haven from Wesleyan University where

she served as women's lacrosse intern under head coach Holly Wheeler since 2002. At Wesleyan, she also served as the Assistant Director of Intramurals and was assistant women's ice hockey coach during the 2002-03 season.

A 2002 graduate of Lafayette College with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Anthropology and Sociology, McClelland was a four-year standout on the lacrosse team, earning four letters and serving as Lafayette's team captain her senior year. She was named Patriot League Rookie of the Year in 1999 and the conference's Offensive Player of the Year in 2001 and 2002. In 2002, Heather was named Patriot League Tournament MVP, as she helped Lafayette to its first-ever automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. She also earned Regional All-American honors for three straight seasons from 2000-2002 and played in the Division I senior All-Star game in 2002.



BETH HEMMINGER ASSISTANT COACH

Beth Hemminger, a 2003 graduate of The College of Wooster (OH), joins the women's lacrosse staff in 2005 following a stellar playing career.

Beth was a three-time All-American attacker for the Scots and holds both North Coast Athletic Conference (NCAC) and school records for goals, assists and points. She was named First Team All-Conference in each of her four seasons, and was named NCAC Player of the Year in 2003. Beth was also a four-year starter for the Wooster soccer team and earned All-Conference and All-Regional accolades from 2001-2003. In 2004, she served as an assistant lacrosse coach for her alma mater, helping them to a first place conference finish.





Eileen Perchinski-Senior Hicksville, NY-Captain

The team's defensive leader. Has been elected co-captain for the second consecutive season. One of the team's most consistent players, who has led the Chargers for the past two seasons in ground balls and caused turnovers. According to head coach McClelland,

"Eileen possesses the speed and quickness to spark the midfield transition out of the defensive end. Her composure and leadership on and off the field have solidified her role as a team leader."

Sandy Schmidt-Senior New Milford, CT

The team's leading scorer in 2004, as she had 25 goals on 55 shots and dished out three assists. Team All-Region. Ranked in the team's top three in draw controls and ground balls last year.

2005 Preview

The 2005 women's lacrosse team returns ten players from last year's squad that posted a 6-7 record and welcomes five new players to the program. The Chargers hope to draw upon their experience from last year's 5-0 start, when the team was ranked as high as number 17 in the nation. New Haven will look to continue that momentum throughout this year's 15-game schedule, as the young program looks to build a winning tradition in West Haven.

Leading the attack for UNH will be senior **Sandy Schmidt**, who finished last year as the team's top goalscorer with 25 along and three assists, and junior **Britt Tregear**, who netted 10 goals and had a team-leading 37 draw controls. Last year's second leading scorer, sophomore **Heather Miles** and classmate **Kristina Conroy** should cause trouble for the opposition's defense. Newcomers on offense include **Allyson Skeens**, **Erin Metcalf**, **Christina Hedley** and returning for her final season, **Lisa Simpson**.

Speaking of defense, the Chargers will be led by senior co-captain Eileen Perchinski, junior Jamie Metcalf plus freshman Christina Hedley and returning two-year starter in goal, Heather Gebhardt. With a solid foundation of experience in the backfield, the 2005 Chargers figure to pose a challenging defense for their opponents.

With much of the team possessing the talent to run the midfield, the coaching staff has confidence that the midfield positions will be interchangeable throughout the year and a real team strength. The Chargers look to cocaptain **Jodi Albert**, sophomores **Jenny Griffin** and **Amy Shields**, and freshman **Maureen Wark** to provide the speed in the midfield to ignite the transition game.

The Chargers kick off the 2005 season in North Carolina where they will face St. Andrew's Presbyterian and 10th-ranked Queens College, March 6 and 8. The team is slated to open its home schedule on March 14 versus Southern Connecticut State University.
