## THE FIRST LOOK

It's a rematch of sorts, but this time around even bigger stakes are on the table as the winner will advance and the loser will look ahead to 2022. Everything before this doesn't matter as the Chargers and Falcons meet in the opening round of the NCAA Division II Playoffs with a date against the top seed in Super Region One, Kutztown, looms next weekend. The Chargers are looking for their second-straight opening round victory on Saturday, while Bentley makes its first appearance in the national tournament since 2004.

## INSIDE THE SERIES

- New Haven and Bentley meet for the 13th time in the history of the two programs.
- The Chargers hold a 9-3 record in the previous 12 meetings, all since football returned to West Haven in 2009.
- Prior to an overtime loss in 2017, the Blue and Gold had won seven straight, with the lone loss in the initial match-up in 2009, a 25-18 decision in West Haven.
- All but five of the games between New Haven and Bentley has been decided by

one possession or less, including a 22-21 nail biter in 2015 with Danny Stock cementing the victory with a 34-yard FG with two seconds remaining in regulation.

## A WIN OVER BENTLEY WOULD...

- be the second straight appearance in the NCAA Division II playoffs that the Chargers have won their opening game, defeating West Chester 35-28 on the road in 2018.
- be the ninth-straight win for the Blue and Gold, with their last loss coming back on September 18 versus Bowie State, another NCAA playoff team (No. 2 in Super Region 2).
- be the 10th overall win in the NCAA Playoffs and the second for the Chargers at DellaCamera Stadium
- be the 265th overall victory in the 42-plus year history of Charger Football.
- be the 234th victory since the Chargers began playing at the Division II level - first DII season was 1982.



### GAME DAY FORECAST

Saturday's forecast in West Haven is nearly a spitting image of last weekend in Rindge, N.H. Gametime temperatures are predicted at 47 degrees under partly sunny skies, with the real-feel temperature at 51 degrees. The low of the day will be 39 degrees and will come in the early morning hours. Winds will come out of the west at six miles per hour with gusts as high as eight mph. Sunrise on Saturday is at 6:46 a.m. and the sun will set at 4:29 p.m.

### SCOUTING THE CHARGERS

For the first time since 2012, the New Haven football team finished its 2021 NE10 schedule undefeated earning the programs fourth NE10 Championship since joining the league. New Haven will once again look for its stingy defense to come up big against the Falcons, holding Bentley to just 95 rushing yards two weeks ago. On the flip side, the Chargers running game was on point, rushing for 295 yards. Overall, the Chargers defense held Bentley to just 215 total yards on offense, well under its 372.6 yards per game average. Marshalling the Blue and Gold's offense is graduate quarterback Connor Degenhardt who has thrown for 1,881 total yards and 17 touchdowns, while he is responsible for 29 total TD's, running in 12. Leading the running game overall is Zach Mauro who has racked up 637 yards rushing, while senior Jake Conlan and freshman Christopher Ais have put up much of the running yards the last few weeks, each entering Saturday with 365 and 222 yards, respectively.

### SCOUTING THE FALCONS

For the first time since 2004 and the third time in program history, the Falcons are in the Division II football playoffs, earning one of seven spots from Super Region One. Entering Saturday's postseason battle, the Falcons are led by the reigning NE10 Player of the Week, quarterback Stephen Sturm who closed out the regular season completing 12-of-13 passes for 239 yards and four touchdowns. For the season, Sturm is averaging 165 yards per game and has thrown 19 touchdowns, while adding six more on the ground. As a team, the majority of the Falcons offense comes from its running game, where they are averaging 206.2 yards per game. Leading the efforts is Andrew Brazicki who is averaging 6.22 yards per carry, which ranks 20th best in all of NCAA Division II.

### NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY

Overall, New Haven earned its eighth bid to the NCAA Division II Football Championship this season, entering the national tournament with an all-time record of 9-7 in postseason play. The most recent appearance came in 2018, which was the first since back-to-back seasons (2011 & 2012), earning a bye to the second round in each year. All-time in the seven previous appearances, New Haven has advanced to the quarterfinal round five times, the semifinal round twice and made one appearance in the National Championship game in 1997 when they fell to Northern Colorado. All-time, New Haven holds a 7-3 record when playing in the Nutmeg State, while they stand at 2-3 in road games and 0-1 in neutral site contests.

### NEXT ON TAP

The winner of this afternoon's NCAA Division II Playoff opening round game will advance to the Super Region 1 semifinal round on Saturday, November 27 and will face the regions topseed Kutztown University. A kickoff time at Kutztown's Andre Reed Stadium remains to be determined. The Golden Bears finished the regular season 10-1 after defeating Slippery Rock in the PSAC Championship game. If the Chargers are victorious today, follow [NewHavenChargers.com](http://NewHavenChargers.com) for updates regarding next weekend's game.

### HOLY HARDWARE

In addition to a conference trophy that will now reside in West Haven, 14 different Chargers will also be adding to their trophy shelves with NE10 All-Conference accolades. Leading the way was graduate center Michael Zecchin who was named the NE10's Offensive Line-man of the Year. Also earning a major conference honor was the Chargers head coach, Chris Pincince who was tabbed the NE10 Coach of the Year, earning the distinction for the first time in his career. In addition to his Of the Year honor, Zecchin was also one of six players named to the All-Conference First Team, joined by Dev Holmes and Briant DeFelice on offense and Khalim Cisse, Khyon Fitzpatrick and Shawn Tafe on defense. Leading six All-Conference Second Team honorees is quarterback Connor Degenhardt, who was joined by Kevin Foelsch and William Ayers on offense as well as Michael Montecalvo, Ryan Hodgins and Ryan Dolce on defense. Rounding out the all-league honors was a pair of All-Rookie players in David Abolarinwa and Neil Brown. See page 8 for a full breakdown of NE10 All-Conference Team.

KEEPING THE STREAK GOING

New Haven wrapped up the regular season winning an NE10 weekly honor for a four-straight week with graduate kicker Briant DeFelice getting the distinction following the Franklin Pierce victory when he was named the Special Teams Player of the Week. DeFelice racked up 10 points in the win over the Ravens, drilling a pair of field goals while going a perfect 4-for-4 in point after attempts. His two field goals came from distances of 20 and 23 yards, while his four PAT's combined with previous outings have him closing out the regular season a perfect 32-of-32 in PAT's in NE10 play.

TRIPLE THREAT

For the a now third straight week, and the fifth time this season, a Charger took home an NE10 weekly honor with senior Khalim Cisse earning Defensive Player of the Week accolades as announced by the conference office. The distinction comes after leading the Chargers defense with seven tackles, including 2.5 sacks in a 31-14 win over Bentley to secure the 2021 NE10 title, the first for New Haven since the 2012 campaign.

HONOR ROLL

For the second straight week and the fourth time this season, a Charger took home an NE10 weekly honor with graduate running back Zach Mauro earning Offensive Player of the Week distinction. Mauro led the Chargers on a rainy Saturday at DellaCamera Stadium, racking up 133 rushing yards on 25 carries, including a seven yard touchdown haul that put the Chargers ahead 14-3 early in the third quarter. His longest run of the day went for 15 yards while his offensive line assisted in providing an extra yard or two on a number of occasions. He also played a key role late in the game with the Chargers running the clock down, including securing a couple of late first downs to extend the drive for New Haven.

NATIONALLY NOTICED

For the third straight week the Chargers are ranked among the best in the country, moving up one spot to No. 18 in the nation on the AFCA Coaches Poll. The initial appearance three weeks ago for the Blue and Gold was the first since ending the 2018 season among the top-25 in the nation. Additionally, the Chargers are also listed among the D2Football.com's top-25 for the second week in a row, listed as No. 23 in the nation in the media poll.

GETTING THE JUMP ON YOU

Freshman Giye Jenkins was quick out of the chute at Stonehill, blocking a pair of Skyhawk punts that each resulted in seven points for the Chargers. His first blocked punt came mid-way through the first quarter with the punt taking place at the Stonehill 21 yard line. That first block was recovered by Kasi

Hazzard at the 10 yard line and run back for the touchdown. On the Skyhawks opening drive of the second half, Jenkins struck again as he penetrated off the right side, this time with Marty Lee-Mitchell corralling the block at the Stonehill five yard line setting up the short field for his offense. Jenkins also added an interception and four tackles on the day, all leading to him earning NE10 Rookie of the Week honors as announced by the conference office.

STICKY FINGERS

New Haven's defense has been impressive all season long and ranks among some of the best in the NCAA heading into the postseason. The biggest of those numbers comes in the fashion of 17 interceptions, including a season-high six against Saint Anselm in week six. The six against the Hawks is the most by any team in a single game this season in all of NCAA DII, while the 17 total is third most in all of Division II. Two of the 17 interceptions have been returned for TD's, both against Saint Anselm, the first by Khyon Fitzpatrick for 58 yards and the second by freshman Christian Ais for 63 yards.

BEHIND THE LINE

Another area where New Haven's defense has made its way onto the national radar is with its ability to drop their opponents behind the line of scrimmage. For the year, the Chargers have racked up 264 loss yards on 66 tackles for loss, with the average 6.6 TFL per game the best in the NE10 and ranked 49th in the nation. Among those 66 TFL are 24 sacks for 149 loss yards. The Chargers 2.4 sacks per game ranks 62nd in the nation. Additionally, the Chargers 14.9 points per game allowed leads the NE10 in total defense and is ranked 14th best in the country.

AIRING IT OUT

The 4,168 fans at DellaCamera Stadium on Family Weekend finally had a chance to see the full potential of Connor Degenhardt's arm as he threw for 355 total yards, completing 14-of-21 passes, including four that ended in the end zone. Among those 14 passes were a pair of long range missiles, the first to Javon Turner for 70 yards and the second to Dev Holmes for 93 yards. The latter of those two passes was the longest play from scrimmage for the Chargers since October of 2000.

NO ONE SHALL ENTER

Against its crosstown rival, the Chargers defense stood tall, not just holding the Owls to nine points but keeping the SCSU offense from scoring a touchdown on any of their 12 drives. Included in the defensive stronghold were three red zone stands that all resulted in field goal attempts by the Owls. Included in those three red zone opportunities was a goal-line stand when the Owls were set up with first and goal at the two yard line but were forced back six yards and eventually held to a 24-yard field goal.

RIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF

Running back Shamar Logan picked up in 2021 right where he left off in 2019, racking up 100+ yards for the sixth time in his career in week one with 104 net yards on 20 attempts against Franklin Pierce. Right out of the gates in game one,

Logan found his feet, getting the ball on the first three plays of the game where he quickly secured the first first down of the season just two plays in. Among his 20 attempts, four went for 10 or more yards, including one for 20+ and the longest of the day, a 30-yard gain that set up at 48-yard TD pass on the next play.

DUST OFF THE SHELF

Quarterback Connor Degenhardt needs to make more room on his shelves, adding a second NE10 Offensive Player of the Week honors to his credit after the win over Saint Anselm. This comes after earning the same honor following the NE10 opener against SCSU in which he threw for 355 yards and four TDs. This past weekend against the Hawks, Degenhardt finished with 199 yards and had a hand in all five offensive TD's, passing for three and rushing for a pair.

DOUBLE DIPPING

Freshman Christian Ais made it a pair of honors for the Chargers following the week-six win over Saint Anselm as he was tabbed the NE10's Rookie of the Week as announced by the league. In addition to one tackle, Ais picked off a pair of passes from the Hawks, including returning one of those 63 yards for a touchdown.

ONE DEGREE ISN'T ENOUGH

With a master's program in sport management, an MBA program and a renowned school of criminal justice it is no wonder so many students call New Haven home when it comes to postgraduate degrees. This season is no different as the Chargers boast 27 grad students on the roster, which according to a new release from the National Football Foundation is the most in Division II. A total of 296 schools responded to a request for information regarding graduate students on current rosters. Two-hundred seventy-nine of those schools listed at least one graduate student and all combined a total of 3,284 collegiate football players will take the field despite having already earned an undergraduate degree.

BOOSTING THE NUMBERS

Without needing to prepare for an opponent since November of 2019, there has been plenty of time for the Chargers coaching staff to find and recruit the next generation of New Haven players and they took full advantage of that extra time, inviting 125 players for the start of preseason camp in early August. Of

the 125 total invitees to camp, 103 will enter today's game as members of the Chargers travel party. Included in that number are 32 letterman returning from the 2019 team and within that number, 14 are listed as starters for the season opener against Franklin Pierce.

HARDWARE HERO

A native of Brooklyn, N.Y. Shamar Logan returns to the gridiron for just the second time as a Charger and it comes after earning some impressive hardware in 2019 when he was named the Northeast-10's Rookie of the Year. Logan finished his first season wearing Blue and Gold with 1,000 net rushing yards which ranks as the seventh most in a single season at New Haven. Those 1,000 yards came on 164 carries and included eight touchdown runs. In addition he added 13 catches for 90 yards and one touchdown. Overall in 2019, Logan finished five games with 100+ yards and three games with a pair of touchdowns. His best outing of the season came on the road at Saint Anselm where he rushed for 175 yards and picked up 21 yards on a pair of catches.

LEADERSHIP TRIO

Following the Chargers three-week pre-season, head coach Chris Pincince announced a trio of players that will make up the leadership corps for 2021; defensive lineman Affiz Din-Gabisi, wide receiver Brett Huber and offensive lineman Mike Zecchin. In addition to the three, a weekly game captain will be named, joining the trio for the on-field coin toss and other game-day responsibilities. All three returned to the Charger football program to extend their collegiate career after earning undergraduate degrees from the University and losing their 2020 seasons due to the CoVID-19 pandemic.

FAMILIAR FACES ON THE SIDELINES

This season, New Haven welcomes a total of eight new faces who were not on the sidelines the last time the Chargers took the field in 2019. Among the new additions are two former Chargers, 2020 graduate Zach Cofrancesco who will coach the defensive back and 1987 graduate Frank Forcucci, a catcher and third baseman on the baseball team, who will lead the linebackers. In addition to be an alum, Forcucci brings a wealth of experience to the New Haven staff serving in a number of different collegiate coaching rolls since 1994, including as the head coach at Becker from 2016-2020. Also among the new additions is Beau Bell, a former linebacker at UNLV who

## CHRIS PINCINCE HEAD COACH SEVENTH SEASON BOSTON UNIVERSITY '94

Chris Pincince takes the helm of the New Haven Chargers football team for his seventh season in 2021. Named the 10th head coach at the University of New Haven in February 2014, Pincince

brought more than 20 years of collegiate coaching experience to the sidelines, including many at the NCAA Division I level.

In six seasons leading the Chargers, Pincince has collected 42 wins and led the Blue and Gold to the NCAA Championship Second Round (2018) for the first time since 2012. Overall in six seasons, 11 players have received All-American accolades while offensive lineman Zach Voytek was a three-time NE10 Offensive Lineman of the Year while also signing as an undrafted free agent with the Buffalo Bills. Additionally, 47 different players have been named All-Conference, while 11 have garnered All-Region honors.

In the most recent season prior to the CoVID-19 shutdown, the Chargers finished tied with Bentley with a 6-2 record in Northeast-10 Conference play. Among the highlights for Pincince's squad was Shamar Logan garnering NE10 Rookie of the Year accolades as he was one of 16 Chargers to earn NE10 postseason distinction. Logan would go on to earn All-Region honors along with Markel Johnson and Ju'an Williams, the latter of which was named the regions Special Teams Player of the Year.

In 2018, Pincince coached a pair of record breakers in quarterback Ajee Patterson and Williams. Patterson graduated as arguably the best quarterback in New Haven history, the first to throw for more than 10,000 yards while racking up 80 touchdowns, second most in program history. The NE10 MVP and First Team All-Conference selection, Patterson closed out his collegiate campaign with a career-high 2,878 yards and 29 touchdowns, leading his squad to the NCAA Championship for the first time since 2012. Williams, a Don Hanson Honorable Mention All-American, registered a single season school record 1,171 receiving yards which came on 65 catches while completing 11 for touchdowns. Joining Williams in earning All-American accolades was Dan Iannone who anchored an offensive line that contributed to 4,827 total yards on offense, the most in the NE10, which included just shy of 2,000 yards rushing. In addition, the O-Line protection was impeccable, allowing Patterson to be sacked just three times through the 10-game regular season.

Voytek was one of two Chargers named All-American in 2016, joining linebacker Tyler Condit. Together, the pair were part of nine total players who received NE10 All-Conference honors following a 7-4 season that included a pair of wins over crosstown rival Southern Connecticut State University, representing eight straight season New Haven has maintained the Elm City Trophy. On the field, Condit set a pair of records, becoming the all-time leading tackler at New Haven as well as in the Northeast-10. He finished his collegiate career with 117 tackles as a senior, becoming just the second player in school history to finish with at least 100 stops in three seasons.

In just his second season leading the Chargers, Pincince led the Blue and Gold to the N10 Championship game, finishing the year with a 7-4 record. Among the highlights were a pair of record setting performances from junior running back Andre Anderson and Condit. Anderson broke a 22 year old record set by Roger Graham when he rushed for 319 yards in the regular season finale against Saint Anselm. In that same game, Condit shattered a 29 year old record when he finished with 25 tackles, giving him 153 for the season, which surpassed the previous record of 134 by Erik Lesinski. Anderson and Condit were two of four Chargers who received NE10 Player of the Year accolades at their respective positions, with Anderson earning Most Valuable Player accolades.

In his first season strolling the sideline at New Haven, Pincince led the Chargers to a 6-5 overall record, including a string

of six straight victories in Northeast-10 Conference action. Among the highlights from Pincince's first season was Condit who was named a USA College Football All-America Honorable Mention. A pair of Chargers were also honored among the major awards from the Northeast-10 Conference with Voytek named co-Offensive Lineman of the Year and freshman running back Lemar Thomas named Rookie of the Year. In total, 10 players were named to NE10 All-Conference squads.

With two previous stints as an assistant at New Haven, Pincince began his career with the Chargers in 1995 as an assistant for UNH Athletics Hall of Famer and former NFL coach Tony Sparano. He spent three additional seasons with the Chargers from 1999 to 2001 under Darren Rizzi, current special teams' coordinator for the New Orleans Saints.

Prior to his most recent position as offensive coordinator at NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) member Elon University in North Carolina, Pincince was the offensive coordinator at the University of Rhode Island and the College of the Holy Cross.

At Elon, Pincince was the offensive coordinator as well as the quarterbacks and running backs coach for three seasons. In his first year Elon's offense led the Southern Conference and ranked 14th nationally with 281 passing yards per game. Pincince's offensive scheme was anchored by All-America wide receiver Aaron Mellette, who led all of FCS in receptions per game (10.27) and receiving yards per game (149). His season totals also set new school and conference records in 2011. Quarterback Thomas Wilson also led the conference and ranked 14th nationally in total offense. In his second season at Elon, the offense ranked 12th in the FCS in passing yards per game (296), with Mellette again earning All-America honors. The receiver became the first Elon player invited to the Senior Bowl and was later selected in the seventh round of the NFL draft by the Baltimore Ravens. In Pincince's final season at Elon, the Phoenix ranked second in the conference in passing yards per game (231) and averaged over 350 total yards per contest.

During the three seasons prior to arriving at Elon, Pincince was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at the University of Rhode Island. While at URI, Pincince installed the spread offense, and the Rams ranked fifth in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) in passing offense in his first season.

Pincince also spent four years at the College of the Holy Cross, including two seasons as the Crusaders' offensive coordinator. In 2007, the Holy Cross offense led the Patriot League in scoring (35.9 ppg), passing (335 ypg), total offense (463 ypg) and first downs (272). Crusaders quarterback Dominic Randolph led the league in passing (3,604 yards), touchdown passes (30) and total offense (340 ypg) and finished 12th in the balloting for the Walter Payton Award. Pincince's first two seasons at Holy Cross were spent as the wide receivers coach.

Prior to his tenure at Holy Cross, Pincince served as the offensive coordinator at Ursinus College in 2003. The season before, Pincince was the quarterbacks coach at Brown University. He also spent two seasons at Fairfield University.

During his five previous seasons at New Haven, the Chargers combined for a 32-18-1 record and advanced to the NCAA Division II quarterfinal round in 1995. The Chargers finished the regular season undefeated and earned a 27-12 victory over Edinboro in the opening round of the NCAA playoffs. In his second stint, the Chargers averaged over 30 points and 350 yards per game during his three-season stretch.

A native of Woonsocket, R.I., Pincince earned his bachelor's degree from Boston University in 1994. He was a member of the Terriers' 1993 Yankee Conference Championship team and played on two NCAA Division I-AA (now FCS) playoff teams. He and his wife, Jennifer, have two sons, Zachary and Owen, and a daughter, Emma.


