SEASON IN REVIEW

The University of New Haven women's basketball team ended the regular season on a good note, picking up a huge 87-76 victory over the Franklin Pierce Ravens on Monday.

SCOUTING NEW HAVEN

The Chargers enter the NE10 Championship First Round fresh off a 87-76 win over Franklin Pierce in their final regular season game of the year.

The Chargers finished the 2021-22 season with a record of 10-15 (5-14 in conference) as they look for revenge in a rematch with Bentley.

Last time the two met was on Feb. 14 when the Chargers traveled to Waltham, Mass. for a Valentine's Day matchup with the Falcons.

New Haven was left heartbroken after suffering a 61-80 loss to Bentley but now they have a chance of redemption as the Falcons will host the Chargers in the first round of the postseason.

Since then the Chargers have been winners of two of their last three games, largely in part to a dominating showing by Aurora Desahies.

During that stretch, the junior forward has racked up 70 points and 49 rebounds on 62.5 percent shooting, including a career-high 31 points over Franklin Pierce on Feb. 21 and a career-high 22 rebounds at Adelphi on Feb. 19.

Deshaies ranked second in the conference with 11.0 rebounds per game as well as second in FG Pct, 53.8%.

Another Charger that set a career-high in points against the Ravens was Briana Van Cleaf, who racked up 22 points.

Kameryn King finished the game with 16 points including a 4-7 effort from beyond the arc to go along with four rebounds and three assists.

DeBose was the fourth and final Charger to reach double-digit points for New Haven in the win. Despite being held to 2-9 shooting from the field, Camryn DeBose drew six free throw attempts, five of which were made, as she ended the game with ten points. The senior guard also recorded four steals in the victory, extending her streak to 19 games while only being held to zero steals once this season. DeBose ranked 14th amongst NE10 scorers this season, ending the regular season with 13.3 points per game.

Brie Pergola scored six points in the effort while tallying seven assists, three rebounds and three steals as the graduate guard ended the season with 3.1 assists per game, which ranks eighth in the conference.

The Ravens ended with 27-63 (42.9%) shooting from the field while going 14-32 (43.8%) from behind the perimeter. The Chargers ended the game shooting 33-65 (50.8%) while shooting 7-20 (35.0%) on three-point attempts. At the line, the Chargers converted 14 of 16 attempts whereas the Ravens shot 8-12. New Haven forced Franklin Pierce into 16 turnovers with four Chargers recording a steal with DeBose leading the defense with four steals while Deshaies and Alyssa Stevenson both blocked a shot.

The Chargers turned those turnovers into 16 points on the other end while Franklin Pierce scored 22 points off of turnovers. New Haven outrebounded the Ravens, 43-29 while dominating in the paint, 42-20. The Chargers outscored Franklin Pierce on second chance opportunities, 25-4.

The Chargers finished the campaign ranked fifth as a team in total rebounds (38.4) while ranking fourth in offensive boards (13.0) and 10th in defensive rebounds (25.4). New Haven ranks 11th in the conference with 59.0 points per game but they are also 8th in the NE10 with 62.3 points allowed per game. The Chargers shoot 38.0 percent on the year while allowing opponents to shoot 37.8 percent.

and 13-6 during conference play, as they are on a one-game win streak after defeating Saint Anselm, 73-62 on Tuesday.

On offense, Bentley is led by graduate forward Autumn Ceppi, who averaged 14.2 points and 7.2 rebounds per game. Ceppi is also 135-278 from the field, this season for a conference fourth-best 48.6 percent.

Last time Bentley hosted the Chargers, Ceppi was shot 6-13 as she racked up 15 points, five rebounds and three assists.

Leading the team that game was Kari Brekke, who shot a perfect 7-7 from the field including 5-5 from beyond the arc as she finished with 20 points.

Brekke averaged 10.9 points during the regular season while leading the conference with 44.2 percent three-point shooting.

Junior guard Ella Thompson averaged 12.9 points, 3.2 rebounds, 2.4 assists per game while shooting 37.6 percent from beyond the perimeter.

Ceppi and Maggie Whitmore both totaled over 130 rebounds on the season, the former ranking 10th in re-

The Falcons have seen eight players start at least one game this season with the most recent lineup being Ceppi, Brekke, Whitmore, Kolleen Bouchard and Hartlee Meier.

On defense, Bentley averages 8.8 steals and 3.3 blocks per game. The Falcons have eight players with 10+ steals on the year, with Ceppi leading the team with 42. Ceppi is also the Falcon's lead shot blocker, with 17 on the season while Kolleen Bouchard follows close behind with 14.

Bentley ranks second in the conference with an average of 68.7 points per game, while shooting a first best 43.6 percent from the field. The Falcons allow an average of 58.8 points per game to their opponent on 40.9 percent shooting. As a whole, they rank eighth in the conference, averaging 36.7 rebounds for a +5.5 margin.

Bentley boasts a diverse roster comprised of eight guards and four forwards. The class makeup is divided into three freshmen, three sophomores, two juniors, three seniors, and one graduate student.

After 18 years working on the staff of Naismith Hall of Fame coach Barbara Stevens, including four as the associate head coach, C White was promoted to Head Women's Basketball Coach at Bentley University in June 2020.

A 2001 graduate of Bentley, White has been involved with the Bentley basketball program for 23 of the last 24 years, beginning as a point guard for the Falcons from 1997-2001. She was a part-time assistant the year following her graduation and after a year on the Harvard University staff, returned to her alma mater before the 2002-03 season as Stevens' top aide.

LAST TIME OUT

The University of New Haven women's basketball team picked up a 87-76 victory over the Franklin Pierce Ravens in their final regular season game of the season. The win brings the Chargers to 10-15 on the year as their conference record rises to 5-14. Just two days after recording a 20-20 double double, Aurora Deshaies once again controlled the offense, racking up a 31 point-19 rebound performance to lift New Haven to a victory. Those 31 points is a new career-high for Deshaies, previously set on Feb. 22 against Assumption while her 19 rebounds ranks second on the season for the junior forward, only behind the 21 she pulled in on Saturday. In her last two games, Deshaies has combined for 53 points and 40 rebounds while shooting 22-36 (61.1%) as she finishes the regular season averaging 12.4 points and 11,0 rebounds, the latter ranking second in conference. Fellow junior forward Briana Van Cleaf also set a career-high in points with 22 while shooting 9-15 (60%). Kameryn King was hot from beyond the arc as four of her five makes came from deep, shooting 4-7 from three. The junior guard also racked up three assists and two rebounds as she finished the game with 16 points. Despite being held to 2-9 shooting from the field, Camryn DeBose drew six free throw attempts, five of which were made, as she ended the game with ten points. The senior guard also recorded four steals in the victory, extending her streak to 19 games while only being held to zero steals once this season. Deshaies put up eight points and grabbed 12 rebounds in the season opening 63-37 win over the Bloomfield Bears. She then followed that by shooting 11-16 (61 percent) against the Georgian Court Lions the next day to finish with a career-high 23 points and 16 rebounds, including nine on offense. To cap off her performance, she tipped in the game-winning shot at the buzzer to send the Chargers home with a 76-74 victory.

Deshaies totaled three double-doubles during her freshman year and has already tallied one, two games into the current season. Deshaies was a four-time NE10 Rookie of the Week in 2019, when she was also named to the NE10 All-Rookie Team at the conclusion of the season after leading the conference in field goal percentage.

CLEANING THE GLASS

For the 12th time this season, the Chargers outrebounded their opponent, 42-30.

New Haven still ranks fourth in the conference with 13.0 offensive rebounds per game.

Aurora Deshaies continues to lead the team with 264 total rebounds or 11.0 rebounds per game, which ranks second in the conference.

Deshaies racked up a career-high 21 rebounds against Adelphi on Feb. 19.

Deshaies has reached 10+ rebounds in 16 out of the 24 games she's played in.

Deshaies was one of five players in the conference with 200+ rebounds as she ranked second to only Meg Knollmeyer of SHNU.

As a team, the Chargers rank fourth in total rebounding while placing fourth in offensive rebounds (13.0) and 10th in defensive rebounds (25.4).

Junior forward Briana Van Cleaf hauled in a career-high 11 rebounds in the Nov. 28 win over Saint Thomas Aquinas. She is 15th in the conference with 6.7 rebounds per game.

The Chargers have been outrebounded 11 times, outrebounded their opponents 12 times and drew even on two occasion against Bloomfield and Saint Michael's.

BRIE PERGOLA

Pergola finished the 2019-20 season with two top-10 single season records. She shot 87.9 percent from the free throw line, the second highest mark of any season in program history, and shot 38.4 percent from three-point range, which ranks eighth all-time.

Pergola averaged 11.0 points per game and 3.2 assists, the latter ranking eighth in the conference.

Pergola set a career-high with 24 points, as well as six three-pointers made, against the College of Staten Island, earlier in the season.

2021-22 GAME NOTES

The Chargers are 3-0 when holding opponents to less than 50 points and are 9-2 when finishing with a better field goal percentage.

The squad also placed third in turnovers forced with an average of 18.7 per game.

Junior Marigona Bacaliu connected on a three-pointer against Bloomfield in week one, to score her first career points as a member of the Chargers.

The Chargers shot a season best 9-30 from three in the 72-64 overtime win over the College of Staten Island, laregly led by Brie Pergola's career-high game.

Gabrielle Stickle and Brianna Diaz both connected on threepointers for their first of the season, against Pace on Nov. 24.

The Chargers hit back-to-back three-pointers twice in the sec-

ond half of the Dec. 1 loss to Southern Conn. State.

Briana Van Cleaf made it rain against Chestnut Hill on Dec. 19, shooting 4-6 from the arc.

Stickle and Bacaliu connected on back-to-back three-pointers in the first quarter against Adelphi on Jan. 17.

The Chargers are averaging 5.0 three-pointers per game on a conference seventh-best 30.9 percent shooting.

DeBose led the team in three-pointers made with 35 but King led in percent (36.8%).

TIS' THE SEASON OF GIVING

New Haven has dished out 293 assists to start the season. Leading the campaign is graduate student Brie Pergola who ranked eighth in the NE10 with an average of 3.2 assists. The team itself is currently ranked 10th with 11.7 assists per game.

STORIED HISTORY

The women's basketball program at New Haven has a very strong history. The Chargers brought home the 1987 national championship title when they defeated Cal-Poly Pomona, 77-75, to lift the trophy. Overall, New Haven has advanced to the national tournament nine times, most recently in back-to-back seasons in 2014 and 2015. The latter of those two seasons saw the Chargers advance to the Elite Eight for just the second time in program history after defeating Stonehill 58-57 to win the East Region Championship.

HEAD COACH THIRD SEASON CORTLAND

Debbie Buff enter her third season at the helm of the Blue and Gold in 2021-22, coming to New Haven prior to the 2018-19 campaign following a seven-year stint at Wheeling Jesuit University (Wheeling, W.V.) which included back-toback Mountain East Conference Championships and NCAA Division II tournament appearances.

In her first two seasons, Buff (36-21) has led the Chargers to back-to-back 18 win campaigns and an appearance in the Northeast-10 Conference tournament in each of her first two seasons. During her second season in 2019-20, Buff led the Chargers to an 18-9 record. New Haven finished the season ninth in the nation in Division II in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 53.7 points per game. NE10 All-Rookie selection Aurora Deshaies led the conference in field goal pct. (.565), senior Micah Wormack earned Second Team All-NE10 honors, and Camryn DeBose was named to the Northeast-10 All-Academic Team.

In her first campaign with the Chargers in 2018-19, Buff led New Haven to an 18-12 record, an improvement of six wins over the season prior to her arrival. The season culminated with a trip to the NE10 semifinals for the first time since 2016 following a road victory over Stonehill in the NE10 quarterfinals. Buff also helped mentor Alexandria Kerr, a First Team All-NE10 honoree and three-time CoSIDA First Team Academic All-District selection.

Prior to New Haven, Buff took over the Wheeling Jesuit program in 2011 and in five years led her first full recruiting class to the first of back-to-back Mountain East Conference Championships in 2015-16. The Cardinals finished that season with a 27-6 overall record, which tied the school record for most victories in a single season.

The Cardinals followed that up with a second-straight 25win season, Mountain East Championship and subsequent trip to the NCAA Division II regional championship. Over her seven years in West Virginia, Buff collected a 111-93 overall record for a .544 winning percentage. Over her seven years, the Cardinals finished with a plus-.500 record on four

Prior to Wheeling Jesuit, Buff spent two seasons at Endicott College where she led the Gulls to the most wins in school history with a 23-6 record in 2008-09 and an appearance in the championship game of the Commonwealth Coast Conference. In her two seasons at Endicott, she compiled an overall record of 42-14.

Her first stint as a head coach came at the Rochester Institute of Technology where her five-plus year career was highlighted by Empire 8 Coach of the Year accolades in 2006-07 when she led the Tigers to the most victories in the history of the RIT women's basketball program and the program's first ever appearance in the Empire 8 and ECAC Championships.

Prior to her collegiate head coaching career, Buff served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at fellow Northeast-10 opponent College of Saint Rose where she helped lead the Golden Knights to the 2000 NCAA Division II Northeast Region Championship, a 34-1 record and a national ranking as high as No. 1 in the country.

Previous to joining a college program, Buff spent 14 years as the head coach at Bishop Maginn High School in Albany. In her time there, she recorded 203 wins and 57 losses while capturing five Big 10 Conference Championships, a Section II title, a regional title and a New York State Class A title. A Hall of Famer at Bishop Maginn, Buff was named the New York State Coach of the Year following the team's 1996 state title run.

A graduate from the State University of New York College at Cortland with a Bachelor of Science degree in physical education, she also holds a Master's Degree in health education from Russell Sage College. During her time at Cortland, she competed three years for the women's basketball team before turning her attention to training for the Skylon International Marathon in New York. In addition to Skylon, Buff has competed in seven triathlons, most notably the Lake Placid Olympic Tour triathlon.

Outside of her coaching and triathlon experiences, Buff has donated countless hours of volunteer time with the Alzheimer's Association and the Make A Wish foundation, both causes near and dear to her heart.
