YEAR IN REVIEW

The Chargers finished the 2019-20 season with a 18-9 record (12-7 NE10), earning the No. 3 seed in the Southwest Division and a spot in the Northeast-10 Quarterfinals for the second straight season.

SCOUTING NEW HAVEN

The Chargers entered the 2019-20 NE10 Tournament as the No. 3 seed in the Southwest Division, their second straight tournament appearance and second year in a row of earning the third seed.

After starting the season 10-1, the second-best start through 11 games in program history, the Chargers had a 2-5 stretch before rebounding to win six of their last eight to close the regular season.

New Haven's defense was a consistent force all season for the Blue and Gold, leading the NE10 and ranking 9th in the nation in scoring defense at 53.7 points per game. The Chargers also led the conference and ranked 8th nationally in FG% defense (.335), and rank fourth in the NE10 by holding the opposition to just 29.0 percent from three-point range. The Chargers also tied for 40th in the nation in rebounding margin (+6.7).

Offensively, the Chargers averaged 56.9 points per game, which ranked 12th in the NE10 that year.

The Chargers ranked seventh in the conference by shooting 40.8 percent overall and shot 29.7 percent from the arc, which sat 11th in the NE10.

The loss of Micah Wormack leaves a hole to be filled, as she led the team in scoring (12.7) and rebounding (7.6).

Aurora Deshaies led the NE10 as a fresh-

man in field goal percentage at 56.5 percent (130-for-230). She finished second on the team in scoring (11.4) and rebounding (7.4).

Brie Pergola ranked seventh in the NE10 with a .384 3-Point FG percentage. She also averaged 3.6 assists per game, which tied her for seventh in the NE10. She ranked fourth on the team in points per game by averaging 9.2 points.

Camryn DeBose scored 17 points in the season finale at Saint Anselm to finish with an even 10.0 points per game, third on the team. She finished second on the squad from beyond the arc, shooting 33 percent.

Point guard Luzdali Ocasio averaged 3.1 assists per game. She had a career-high 10 assists at Chestnut Hill on December 11.

SCOUTING THE BEARS/LIONS

The Chargers will start out their season with back-to-back games games against CACC opponents. New Haven will take on Bloomfield on Saturday, Nov. 13 at Moore Field House in New Haven at 6:00 PM before playing Georgian Court the next day at 1:00 PM at the same location.

The Bloomfield Bears finished the 2019-20 season with a 5-14 record, with an 0-3 record against NE10 teams. However, the Bears played in 11 games last year, ending with a 6-5 record.

During that season, the Bears were led in scoring by senior forward Jaylah Bennett, who put up 11.8 points per game and averged 4.4 rebounds, as well.

Also returning for Bloomfield is redshirt-junior forward DaShanique Ruffin, who finished second in the CACC

with 8.8 boards per game. Ruffin ended the year with 9.4 points per game, ranking third on the team that season.

Bloomfield lost Alaisha Mumford who lead the team in assists, finishing with over 50 assists in each of the last two seasons.

Despite ending with an 8-11 record during the 2019-20 season, the Georgian Court Lions rebounded with an 9-2 season, 7-0 in conference play, last year.

Georgian Court finished last season with three players averaging over ten points a game.

The Lions were led by guard Anyssa Fields who put up a conference-high 18.4 ppg last season, while also leading the team with 10.7 rebounds per outing.

- 2020-21 CACC FG% leader, Leighanna Lister is still in the paint for Georgian Court. She averaged 8.2 rebounds per game, fifth most in conference.

LAST TIME OUT

It's been 630 days since the Chargers last competed in a regular season game. The last time the squad took the court, however, was the quarterfinals of the Northeast-10 Conference Championship Tournament against #2 seed Saint Anselm on March 1, 2020.

Tied after three quarters and trailing by one with just over seven minutes remaining, Saint Anselm closed the game on a 13-3 run to put New Haven away, 55-44.

Camryn DeBose led the team with 17 points on 8-of-15 shooting, Aurora Deshaies scored 12 points on 5-of-9 from the field and tied for a team-leading eight rebounds. Bionca Chambers scored seven points.

New Haven held Saint Anselm's offense, which averaged nearly 75 points per game, to a season-low 55 points. The Chargers were the only team to hold the Hawks to under 60 points that season, having done so twice, having previously held Saint Anselm to 58 at Charger Gymnasium back on January 22, 2020.

For the game, the Chargers shot 34.0 percent from the floor while holding the Hawks to 36.1 percent. Saint A's controlled the glass 44-32 and outscored New Haven 15-6 on second-chances.

New Haven finished the season at 18-9 overall. their first time with consecutive 18-win seasons since 2014-15. Saint Anselm went on to upset Adelphi in the NE10 semifinals, before falling at Stonehill in the championship game.

ALL-CONFERENCE PERFORMER

AURORA DESHAIES

Deshaies finished a solid rookie campaign second on the team in both scoring (11.4) and rebounding (7.4).

She led the Northeast-10 in field goal percentage at .565 and was the only freshman in the conference to rank in the top 25 in scoring, top 15 in rebounding and top 15 in field goal percentage.

She collected three double-doubles, scored in double figures on 17 occasions and recorded double digit rebounds six times. She scored a season-high 20 points while hauling in six rebounds on 8-of-11 shooting in the seasonopener against Staten Island, en route to winning the first of a league-leading four NE10 Rookie of the Week awards.

She had 13 rebounds on two occasions and pulled down a season-high 14 against American Int'l on Feb. 15. She totaled 14 points and eight rebounds in back-to-back games at Le Moyne and Saint Rose in February.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

New Haven's 59 rebounds against AIC were the most since the team had 50 at Dominican last season on Jan. 2, 2019.

New Haven was outrebounded only four times all season: Jan. 22 and Mar. 1 against Saint Anselm, Feb. 8 at Le Moyne and Feb. 22 vs. Adel-

They have outrebounded their opponents in 20 games this season, and drew even on three occasions against Pace, Stonehill and Assumption. New Haven's +6.7 rebounding margin was second in the NE10 and t-40th in the nation in DII.

BRIE PERGOLA

Pergola finished the season with two top-10 single season records. She shot 87.9 percent from the free throw line, the second highest mark of any season in program history, and shot 38.4 percent from three-point range, which ranks eighth all-time.

DEBOSE KNOWS ALL

Cam DeBose was one of 11 women's basketball student-athletes to be named Academic All-Conference by the Northeast-10 for the 2019-20 season. DeBose posted a 3.86 GPA during the Fall 2019 semester and holds a 3.93 cumulative GPA as a psychology major with a concentration in forensic psychology. DeBose has posted a 4.0 semester GPA during the Spring 2019 semester.

BACK-TO-BACK!

Freshman forward Aurora Deshaies was named the Northeast-10's Rookie of the Week a league-leading four times in 2019-20.

During her final win for the week of Feb. 10-16, she averaged a double-double with 11.5 points and 11.0 rebounds while leading the Chargers to a 2-0 week with wins over Saint Rose and American International. She also added in 2.5 steals per game, shot .412 from the floor and was a perfect 9-for-9 from the free throw line.

The Syracuse, N.Y. native started her week with 14 points and eight rebounds at Saint Rose on Wednesday, while shooting 5-of-8 from the floor. On Saturday against American Int'l, she tallied nine points and a career-high 14 rebounds while adding two steals and going 5-for-5 from the free throw line. Her career performance on the boards helped New Haven outrebound the Yellow Jackets 59-26, including helping the Chargers haul in 22 offensive rebounds compared to AIC's 15 defensive boards.

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

The Chargers allowed under 50 points in 12 games this season, including 40 points to then-No. 19 Bentley a season-low 35 points to Pace on Feb. 5. The Chargers are ninth in all of DII women's basketball in scoring defense by allowing just 53.7 ppg.

DOWNTOWN TURNAROUND

Over the last two regular season games against SCSU and Adelphi, the Chargers shot a combined 9-for-20 from three-point range. They went 5-for-12 against SCSU and 4-for-8 against Adelphi.

Prior to that, New Haven had connected on

just two of their 30 attempts over the previous three games (.067) and were 5-for-40 (.125) over the previous four games.

UPSET CENTRAL

The Chargers' win over No. 19 Bentley was their first win over a ranked opponent since defeating No. 13 Stonehill 58-57 on March 16, 2015 in the NCAA East Region Championship finals.

OCASIO'S CAREER-HIGHS

Luzdali Ocasio ranked t-14th in the NE10 with 3.1 assists per game. She came away with a career-high seven steals on Jan. 22 against Saint Anselm, surpassing her previous careerhigh of four, which she set earlier that season against Le Moyne. She also racked up a careerhigh 11 points, helped by a career-high three three-pointers against Bentley on January 14. She set a career-high with six rebounds at Saint Michael's on January 11 and boasted a 10 assist effort at Chestnut Hill on December 11.

TIS' THE SEASON OF GIVING

New Haven dished out 22 assists at Chestnut Hill on December 11. It was the most assists by the Chargers since they had 20 against Southern Connecticut on February 4, 2014.

STORIED HISTORY

The women's basketball program at New Haven has a very strong history. The Chargers brought home the 1987 national championship title when they defeated Cal-Poly Pomona, 77-75, to lift the trophy. Overall, New Haven has advanced to the national tournament nine times, most recently in back-to-back seasons in 2014 and 2015. The latter of those two seasons saw the Chargers advance to the Elite Eight for just the second time in program history after defeating Stonehill 58-57 to win the East Region Championship.

Debbie Buff enter her third season at the helm of the Blue and Gold in 2021-22, coming to New Haven prior to the 2018-19 campaign following a seven-year stint at Wheeling Jesuit University (Wheeling, W.V.) which included back-to-back Mountain East Conference Championships and NCAA Division II tournament appearances.

In her first two seasons, Buff (36-21) has led the Chargers to back-to-back 18 win campaigns and an appearance in the Northeast-10 Conference tournament in each of her first two seasons. During her second season in 2019-20, Buff led the Chargers to an 18-9 record. New Haven finished the season ninth in the nation in Division II in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 53.7 points per game. NE10 All-Rookie selection Aurora Deshaies led the conference in field goal pct. (.565), senior Micah Wormack earned Second Team All-NE10 honors, and Camryn DeBose was named to the Northeast-10 All-Academic Team.

In her first campaign with the Chargers in 2018-19, Buff led New Haven to an 18-12 record, an improvement of six wins over the season prior to her arrival. The season culminated with a trip to the NE10 semifinals for the first time since 2016 following a road victory over Stonehill in the NE10 quarterfinals. Buff also helped mentor Alexandria Kerr, a First Team All-NF10 honoree and three-time CoSIDA First Team Academic All-District selection.

Prior to New Haven, Buff took over the Wheeling Jesuit program in 2011 and in five years led her first full recruiting class to the first of back-to-back Mountain East Conference Championships in 2015-16. The Cardinals finished that season with a 27-6 overall record, which tied the school record for most victories in a single season.

The Cardinals followed that up with a second-straight 25-win season, Mountain East Championship and subsequent trip to the NCAA Division II regional championship. Over her seven years in West Virginia, Buff collected a 111-93 overall record for a .544 winning percentage. Over her seven years, the Cardinals finished with a plus-.500 record on four occasions.

Prior to Wheeling Jesuit, Buff spent two seasons at Endicott College where she led the Gulls to the most wins in school history with a 23-6 record in 2008-09 and an appearance in the championship game of the Commonwealth Coast Conference. In her two seasons at Endicott, she compiled an overall record of 42-14.

Her first stint as a head coach came at the Rochester Institute of Technology where her five-plus year career was highlighted by Empire 8 Coach of the Year accolades in 2006-07 when she led the Tigers to the most victories in the history of the RIT women's basketball program and the program's first ever appearance in the Empire 8 and ECAC Championships.

Prior to her collegiate head coaching career, Buff served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at fellow Northeast-10 opponent College of Saint Rose where she helped lead the Golden Knights to the 2000 NCAA Division II Northeast Region Championship, a 34-1 record and a national ranking as high as No. 1 in the country.

Previous to joining a college program, Buff spent 14 years as the head coach at Bishop Maginn High School in Albany. In her time there, she recorded 203 wins and 57 losses while capturing five Big 10 Conference Championships, a Section II title, a regional title and a New York State Class A title. A Hall of Famer at Bishop Maginn, Buff was named the New York State Coach of the Year following the team's 1996 state title run.

A graduate from the State University of New York College at Cortland with a Bachelor of Science degree in physical education, she also holds a Master's Degree in health education from Russell Sage College. During her time at Cortland, she competed three years for the women's basketball team before turning her attention to training for the Skylon International Marathon in New York. In addition to Skylon, Buff has competed in seven triathlons, most notably the Lake Placid Olympic Tour triathlon.

Outside of her coaching and triathlon experiences, Buff has donated countless hours of volunteer time with the Alzheimer's Association and the Make A Wish foundation, both causes near and dear to her heart.
