SEASON IN REVIEW

The Chargers picked up their fourth win of the season in a 56-43 win over Saint Thomas Aquinas to break a two game skid.

SCOUTING NEW HAVEN

The Chargers enter Wednesday's matchup against the Southern Connecticut State Owls, looking to pick up their first conference win of the season.

The team broke a two-game skid last time out in a 56-43 home win over the Saint Thomas Aguinas Spartans on Sunday.

New Haven jumped out to an early lead in the first quarter, ending with a 14-9 lead but soon found themselves trailing at the half, 30-25, after outscoring the Chargers, 21-11 in the second quarter.

Despite holding the Spartans to 0-4 shooting from the three in the first, Saint Thomas Aguinas went on a tear in the second, shooting 5-6 from the distance.

The New Haven defense held strong, however, holding the Spartans to only 6-23 (26%) shooting for the entire second half.

The Chargers went 20-55 (36.4%) from the field but were held to 4-17 (23.5%) shooting from beyond the arc.

Leading the Charger's offense was graduate guard Brie Pergola, who caught fire in the second half, scoring 13 points, including three three-pointers. Pergola finished the game with 18 total points while also tallying four rebounds, three assists, a block and a steal.

Camryn DeBose once again reached double-digit scoring with 13 points on 29 percent shooting while adding a threepointer of her own. She also finished with a season-high seven rebounds and two blocks in the winning effort.

DeBose currently ranks sixth for scorers in the NE-10 Conference with a teamleading 16.2 points per game. She also ranks top-15 in the conference with an average of 1.8 steals per game.

Junior forwards Aurora Deshaies and Briana Van Cleaf combined for 17 points and 23 rebounds in the low post, as both reached double-digit rebounds.

For the first time since Dec. 15, 2020, New Haven saw two players reach 10+ rebounds in a game, last accomplished by Micah Wormack (18) and Deshaies

Van Cleaf's career-high 11 boards in Sunday's win, pushes her season average to 7.5, which is t-11th in the NE10.

Deshaies is averaging 11.2 points and rebounds per game, the latter securing her fifth in the conference.

SCOUTING THE OWLS

The Owls enter the game on a two-game win streak with a 3-2 record, coming off a 68-52 non-conference win over the Holy Family Tigers on Sunday.

Southern Connecticut State saw a combination of only six scorers in the winning effort, with four reaching doubledigit points.

Graduate forward Jessica Fessle led the Owls in their last game with an 18 point-18 rebound double-double.

The Chargers traveled to Moore Field House to start the season in the SCSU Tip-off Tournament, but did not compete against the Owls while there.

2021-22 GAME NOTES

SCSU ranks fourth in the conference with an average of 69.8 points per game, while shooting a 12th best 36.1 percent from the field.

Fressle leads the Owls on the year in scoring, as well as on the glass, with 18 points and 13 rebounds per game.

Senior guard Zoe Amalbert is the team's second-leading scorer with 14.4 points per game on 38.5 percent shooting from the field and from beyond the arc. Amalbert also handily leads the Owls with 25 assists on the year.

From the three, SCSU's Patricia Conroy has been a sharp-shooter, entering the matchup shooting 42.4 percent on the long ball. Conroy has made 14 three pointers this season, hitting an NE10 second-best 2.8 threes per game.

Southern Connecticut State allows an average of 63.0 points per game to their opponent on 38.8 percent shooting. As a whole, they rank second in the conference, averaging 46.6 rebounds for a +11.6 margin.

SCSU boast a diverse roster comprised of 10 guards and four forwards. The class makeup is divided into three freshmen, two sophomores, three juniors, two seniors and four graduate students.

Kate Lynch entered her seventh season as head women's basketball coach at Southern Connecticut State University. Lynch, an '08 graduate, was a 2018 inductee into the Southern Connecticut State University Alumni Hall of Fame.

The all-time leading scorer in the history of the Southern Connecticut State women's basketball program, Lynch was announced as head coach on June 29, 2015.

Lynch enters the match with a 79-73 overall record and 45-55 conference record at the helm of SCSU.

LAST TIME OUT

The New Haven women's basketball team picked up their fourth win of the season in a 56-43 victory over the Saint Thomas Aguinas Spartans on Sunday to break a two game skid. Brie Pergola was lights out for the Chargers, leading the team with 18 points on 6-13 shooting, including 3-6 from beyond the arc. Pergola added four rebounds, three assists, a block and a steal to her stat line in the winning effort, as well. Camryn DeBose put up 13 points in game to bring her season average to 16.2 points per game, which ranks sixth most amongst scorers in the NE10. New Haven cleaned the boards in a major way, outrebounding the Spartans, 47-29. Junior forwards Aurora Deshaies and Briana Van Cleaf nearly achieved double-doubles as

they each reached double-digit rebounds. Deshaies finished the game with eight points and 12 rebounds while Van Cleaf ended with nine points and eleven boards. Deshaies ranks fifth in the conference with 11.2 rebounds per game while Van Cleaf is tied for 11th, averaging 7.5 rebounds.

The Spartans were held to 18-53 (34%) shooting, with a low of 3-13 (23.1%) in the third quarter. Saint Thomas Aquinas also went 6-19 (31.6%) from the three while also attempting one free throw in the entire game. The 43 points allowed by the Chargers is the second-lowest allowed so far this season, second only to the season opening 63-37 win over the Bloomfield Bears. New Haven forced the Spartans into 12 turnovers, while totaling four blocks and four steals. Leading the defensive effort was senior guard DeBose, who tallied two blocks to tie a career-high, last achieved on Feb. 1. 2020 against Franklin Pierce.

As a whole, the squad shot 20-55 (36.4%) from the field, while going 4-17 (23.5%) from beyond the arc. In a game were their was eight lead changes, free throws were vital as the Chargers went 12-22 (54.5%) from the line as opposed to Saint Thomas Aguinas' 1-1. Ten of New Haven's points came off turnovers while 18 came on second chance opportunities. The Chargers dominated the post, outscoring the Spartans 26-16 from inside the paint.

QUOTE FROM BUFF

"Today, we had pride on defense and played with discipline on offense," said head coach Debbie Buff. "We out-rebounded a good rebounding team and played the hardest together as a team. We need to build on that. I'm proud of our energy and grit that we showed throughout the game."

NE10 Player of the week

AURORA DESHAIES

The Chargers ended the first weekend on a two-game win streak, largely in part to junior forward Aurora Deshaies, who was awarded NE10 Player of the Week honors for averaging a double-double over that span with 15.5 ppg and 14.0 rpg while shooting 56 percent from the field.

Deshaies put up eight points and grabbed 12 rebounds in the season opening 63-37 win over the Bloomfield Bears. She then followed that by shooting 11-16 (61 percent) against the Georgian Court Lions the next day to finish with a career-high 23 points and 16 rebounds, including nine on offense. To cap off her performance, she tipped in the game-winning shot at the buzzer to send the Chargers home with a 76-74 victory.

Deshaies totaled three double-doubles during her freshman year and has already tallied one, two games into the current season. Deshaies was a four-time NE10 Rookie of the Week in 2019, when she was also named to the NE10 All-Rookie Team at the conclusion of the season after leading the conference in field goal percentage.

CLEANING THE GLASS

New Haven dominated under the basket in Sunday's win, outrebounding the Spartans, 47-29.

The Chargers pulled down 17 offensive rebounds, while scoring 18 points on second chance opportunities.

New Haven also outscored the Spartans, 26-16, in the paint.

Aurora Deshaies, who marked her 10th career game with 10+ rebounds on Sunday, leads the team with 67 total rebounds or 11.2 rebounds per game, which ranks fifth in the conference.

As a team, the Chargers rank seventh in total rebounding while placing fourth in offensive rebounds (15.6) and ninth in defensive rebounds (26.3).

Junior forward Briana Van Cleaf hauled in a career-high 11 rebounds in the win over Saint Thomas Aquinas. She is tied for fourteenth in the conference with 7.5 rebounds per game.

So far, the Chargers have been outrebounded three times, outrebounded their opponents twice and drew even on one occasion against Bloomfield.

BRIE PERGOLA

Pergola finished the 2019-20 season with two top-10 single season records. She shot 87.9 percent from the free throw line, the second highest mark of any season in program history, and shot 38.4 percent from three-point range, which ranks eighth all-time.

Pergola is currently averaging 14.0 points per game and 3.5 assists, both ranking her within the top-12 in the NE10.

Pergola set a career-high with 24 points, as well as six three-pointers made, against the College of Staten Island, last week.

Her previous career-high was 20 points, last vs. Goldey-Beacom on Jan. 1, 2020. Her high in three-pointers was four, last accompolished at Chestnut Hill on Dec. 11, 2019.

She tallied her fifth game with 10 or more points on Sunday against the Saint Thomas Aquinas Spartans, leading the team with 18 points while going 3-6 from three.

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

The Chargers started the season off by holding the Bloomfield Bears to only 37 points, two short of their season-low in the 2019-20 season

On Sunday, the Chargers held the Spartans to 43 points, second lowest allowed after Bloomfield.

New Haven has held their opponents to 33.9 percent shooting on the season, which ranks first in the NE10. The Chargers also only allow a conference fifth best, 28 percent shooting from the perimeter.

The five starters have combined for 38 steals

Junior Marigona Bacaliu connected on a threepointer against Bloomfield in week one, to score her first career points as a member of the Chargers.

The Chargers shot a season best 9-30 from three in the 72-64 overtime win over the College of Staten Island, laregly led by Brie Pergola's career-high game.

Gabrielle Stickle and Brianna Diaz both connected on three-pointers for their first of the season, against Pace on Nov. 24.

TIS' THE SEASON OF GIVING

New Haven has dished out 55 assists to start the season. Leading the campaign is graduate student Brie Pergola who is tied for sixth in the NE10 with an average of 3.5 assists and tied for fifth with a season total of 21. The team itself is currently ranked 14th with 9.2 assists per game.

STORIED HISTORY

The women's basketball program at New Haven has a very strong history. The Chargers brought home the 1987 national championship title when they defeated Cal-Poly Pomona, 77-75, to lift the trophy. Overall, New Haven has advanced to the national tournament nine times, most recently in back-to-back seasons in 2014 and 2015. The latter of those two seasons saw the Chargers advance to the Elite Eight for just the second time in program history after defeating Stonehill 58-57 to win the East Region Championship.

NE10 TOURNAMENT HISTORY

New Haven qualified last season for the quarterfinals for the seventh time in 11 years since joining the NE10 prior to the 2008-09 season.

The Chargers hold a 4-4 record all-time in the NE10 quarterfinals, and won in two straight trips to the quarterfinals with road upsets in 2016 at Saint Anselm and 2019 at Stonehill.

EBBIE BUFF

HEAD COACH SECOND SEASON CORTLAND

Debbie Buff enter her third season at the helm of the Blue and Gold in 2021-22, coming to New Haven prior to the 2018-19 campaign following a seven-year stint at Wheeling Jesuit University (Wheeling, W.V.) which included back-toback Mountain East Conference Championships and NCAA Division II tournament appearances.

In her first two seasons, Buff (36-21) has led the Chargers to back-to-back 18 win campaigns and an appearance in the Northeast-10 Conference tournament in each of her first two seasons. During her second season in 2019-20, Buff led the Chargers to an 18-9 record. New Haven finished the season ninth in the nation in Division II in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 53.7 points per game. NE10 All-Rookie selection Aurora Deshaies led the conference in field goal pct. (.565), senior Micah Wormack earned Second Team All-NE10 honors, and Camryn DeBose was named to the Northeast-10 All-Academic Team.

In her first campaign with the Chargers in 2018-19, Buff led New Haven to an 18-12 record, an improvement of six wins over the season prior to her arrival. The season culminated with a trip to the NE10 semifinals for the first time since 2016 following a road victory over Stonehill in the NE10 quarterfinals. Buff also helped mentor Alexandria Kerr, a First Team All-NE10 honoree and three-time CoSIDA First Team Academic All-District selection.

Prior to New Haven, Buff took over the Wheeling Jesuit program in 2011 and in five years led her first full recruiting class to the first of back-to-back Mountain East Conference Championships in 2015-16. The Cardinals finished that season with a 27-6 overall record, which tied the school record for most victories in a single season.

The Cardinals followed that up with a second-straight 25win season, Mountain East Championship and subsequent trip to the NCAA Division II regional championship. Over her seven years in West Virginia, Buff collected a 111-93 overall record for a .544 winning percentage. Over her seven years, the Cardinals finished with a plus-.500 record on four occasions.

Prior to Wheeling Jesuit, Buff spent two seasons at Endicott College where she led the Gulls to the most wins in school history with a 23-6 record in 2008-09 and an appearance in the championship game of the Commonwealth Coast Conference. In her two seasons at Endicott, she compiled an overall record of 42-14.

Her first stint as a head coach came at the Rochester Institute of Technology where her five-plus year career was highlighted by Empire 8 Coach of the Year accolades in 2006-07 when she led the Tigers to the most victories in the history of the RIT women's basketball program and the program's first ever appearance in the Empire 8 and ECAC Championships.

Prior to her collegiate head coaching career, Buff served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at fellow Northeast-10 opponent College of Saint Rose where she helped lead the Golden Knights to the 2000 NCAA Division II Northeast Region Championship, a 34-1 record and a national ranking as high as No. 1 in the country.

Previous to joining a college program, Buff spent 14 years as the head coach at Bishop Maginn High School in Albany. In her time there, she recorded 203 wins and 57 losses while capturing five Big 10 Conference Championships, a Section II title, a regional title and a New York State Class A title. A Hall of Famer at Bishop Maginn, Buff was named the New York State Coach of the Year following the team's 1996 state title run.

A graduate from the State University of New York College at Cortland with a Bachelor of Science degree in physical education, she also holds a Master's Degree in health education from Russell Sage College. During her time at Cortland, she competed three years for the women's basketball team before turning her attention to training for the Skylon International Marathon in New York. In addition to Skylon, Buff has competed in seven triathlons, most notably the Lake Placid Olympic Tour triathlon.

Outside of her coaching and triathlon experiences, Buff has donated countless hours of volunteer time with the Alzheimer's Association and the Make A Wish foundation, both causes near and dear to her heart.
