

SEASON IN REVIEW

The Chargers are now 4-3 on the year after dropping their third conference game and third overall game of the season on Wednesday in an 83-64 loss to the Southern Connecticut State Owls.

SCOUTING NEW HAVEN

The Chargers enter Saturday's matchup against the Saint Rose Golden Knights, still looking to pick up their first conference win of the season.

The team split the two-game homestead, picking up a 56-43 win over the Saint Thomas Aquinas Spartans but dropped last Wednesday's in-state rivalry matchup against the Southern Connecticut State Owls, 83-64.

Overcoming a nine point deficit in the first quarter, the Chargers fought back, as Camryn DeBose hit a three as time expired to send both teams into the second quarter with 16 points.

The Chargers soon fell victim to the velocity of Southern's sharp shooters, as the Owls would finish the game going 15-34 (44.1%) from the arc.

DeBose had yet another solid performance and she went 6-13 from the field and 3-6 from the three, giving her 15 points to go with six rebounds and three assists.

DeBose currently resides at seventh in the conference in points per game with 16, while also making noise on defense, tying for ninth with two steals per game.

Junior forward Auroro Deshaies racked up a 14 point-13 rebound double-double in the effort, her second of the year and fifth of her career.

Deshaies helped the Chargers outscore

the Owls, 36-14, in the paint. She has the highest field goal percentage in the NE10, making nearly 60% of her shots, while pulling down a conference fourthbest 11.4 average rebounds.

Seeing time on the court were juniors Kameryn King and Alyssa Stevenson, who combined for eight rebounds in the game, six of which offensive.

The Chargers went 26-64 (40.6%) from the field but were more effeicent from deep, going 7-16 (43.8%) from beyond the arc.

Brie Pergola was quiet on the scoreboard, making two three-pointers to end with six points, but tallied two rebounds and two assists.

Her 3.3 assists per game ties her at ninth in the conference, while her 23 total assists places her fifth.

New Haven only forced 14 turnovers in the loss, turning those into 19 points on the other end.

The Chargers also scored 15 points on second chance opportunities but were outscored on the fastbreak, 13-4.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN KNIGHTS

The Golden Knights enter the matchup 1-4 on the season and 1-2 during conference play.

After defeating the Le Moyne Dolphins in a 73-72 overtime win, the Golden Knights fell to the Pace Setters in a 69-44 loss on Wednesday.

In the loss, the Knights saw a 11 different scorers despite no one reaching doubledigits.

On the season, Saint Rose is led by fifth

year forward Nina Fedullo who is averaging 10 points and 6.8 rebounds per game.

Fedullo is also a stout rim defender for Saint Rose, ranking second in the conference with two blocks per game.

Junior guard Becca Townes is the team's deep threat, shooting 30.4 percent from the perimeter, averaging 9.4 points per game.

Saint Rose ranks 14th in the conference with an average of 55.2 points per game, while shooting a seventh best 38.8 percent from the field.

The Golden Knights allow an average of 65.8 points per game to their opponent on 41 percent shooting. As a whole, they rank 12th in the conference, averaging 34.6 rebounds for a -0.4 margin.

Saint Rose boasts a young roster comprised of 10 guards, four forwards and two guard/forwards. The class makeup is divided into eight freshmen, four sophomores, three juniors, and one fifth year.

Whitney Edwards was named the head women's basketball coach at The College of Saint Rose on June 1, 2020.

An NCAA Division I standout player, she has coached at all three NCAA levels throughout the past 14 years. She is also a former assistant coach at fellow Northeast-10 Conference member Stonehill College and has successfully recruited the Northeast Region corridor from Ontario to Maryland.

LAST TIME OUT

The New Haven women's basketball team dropped their third game of the season in a 83-64 loss to NE10 and in-state rival Southern Connecticut State on Wednesday night as their conference woes continue. Camryn DeBose (Wellington, Fla./Wellington Community) led the Chargers with 15 points on 6-13 (46.2%) shooting, including 3-6 (50%) from the perimeter. DeBose did a little bit of everything for New Haven, ending with six rebounds and three assists, in addition to three steals on the defensive end. Junior forward Aurora Deshaies (Syracuse, N.Y./Bishop Ludden) had a dominate performance in the paint, finishing with a 14 point-13 rebound double-double, her second double-double of the season. Junior guard Kameryn King (Old Saybrook, Conn./Mercy) saw 17 minutes of playing time and capitalized on it, scoring a career-high 11 points on 4-6 (66.7%) shooting, while making her only attempted three-pointer. King also had a strong showing on the glass, grabbing another career-high five rebounds, four of which on the offense. Brie Pergola (Torrington, Conn./Torrington) was held

to a season-low six points with her two made shots coming from beyond the arc. Rounding out the starting five is Briana Van Cleaf (Staten Island, N.Y./Notre Dame Academy) and Bionca Chambers (Bronx, N.Y./New Milford), who put up nine and seven points, respectively. Junior forward Alyssa Stevenson (Watertown, N.Y./ South Jefferson Central) saw six minutes of action, scoring her first points of the season while also pulling in three rebounds.

The Owls shot 26-58 (44.8%) from the field while making 15 of 34 attempts from the three. Southern Connecticut State also went 16-21 (76.1%) from the line, while the Chargers went 5-10 (50%). The two remained tied at 16 going into the second quarter but after outscoring the Chargers, 23-10, the Owls took control. The 34 three-pointers attempted by the Owls are the most the Chargers have faced this season, so far, New Haven forced Southern Connecticut State into 12 turnovers, while totaling eight steals and one block. DeBose tallied three steals and King finished with two, while Deshaies was credited with the only block for the Chargers. DeBose is noe tied for tenth in the NE10 with 2 steals per game.

As a whole, the squad shot 26-64 (40.6%) from the field, while going 7-16 (43.8%) from beyond the arc. In a game were their was six lead changes, three-pointers made the difference as the Chargers fell victim to the long ball. 19 of New Haven's points came off turnovers while 15 came on second chance opportunities. The Chargers dominated the post, outscoring the Owls 36-14 from inside the paint.

DeBose is now ranked seventh of all scorers in the conference with 16 points per game while Pergola fell to 14th with 12.9. Deshaies's 11.4 average rebounds puts her in sole possession of fourth in the NE10, while her 59.7 field goal percent ranks first amongst scorers. With two more assists, Pergola is now also tied for eighth with 3.3 assists per game.

The Chargers ended the first weekend on a two-game win streak, largely in part to junior forward Aurora Deshaies, who was awarded NE10 Player of the Week honors for averaging a double-double over that span with 15.5 ppg and 14.0 rpg while shooting 56 percent from

Deshaies put up eight points and grabbed 12 rebounds in the season opening 63-37 win over the Bloomfield Bears. She then followed that by shooting 11-16 (61 percent) against the Georgian Court Lions the next day to finish with a career-high 23 points and 16 rebounds, in-

cluding nine on offense. To cap off her performance, she tipped in the game-winning shot at the buzzer to send the Chargers home with a 76-74 victory.

Deshaies totaled three double-doubles during her freshman year and has already tallied one, two games into the current season. Deshaies was a four-time NE10 Rookie of the Week in 2019, when she was also named to the NE10 All-Rookie Team at the conclusion of the season after leading the conference in field goal percentage.

CLEANING THE GLASS

Despite the loss, New Haven dominated under the basket on Wednesday, outrebounding the Owls, 41-34.

The Chargers pulled down 10 offensive rebounds, while scoring 15 points on second chance opportunities.

New Haven also outscored the Owls, 36-14, in the paint.

Aurora Deshaies racked up a 14 point-13 rebound double-double in the loss to SCSU, her second double-double this season and fifth of her career.

Deshaies leads the team with 80 total rebounds or 11.4 rebounds per game, which ranks fourth in the conference.

Junior guard Kameryn King crashed the boards on Wednesday, grabbing four offensive rebounds.

As a team, the Chargers rank fifth in total rebounding while placing second in offensive rebounds (14.7) and tied for eighth in defensive rebounds (26.0).

Junior forward Briana Van Cleaf hauled in a career-high 11 rebounds in the win over Saint Thomas Aquinas. She is 16th in the conference with 6.7 rebounds per game.

So far, the Chargers have been outrebounded three times, outrebounded their opponents three times and drew even on one occasion against Bloomfield.

BRIE PERGOLA

Pergola finished the 2019-20 season with two top-10 single season records. She shot 87.9 percent from the free throw line, the second highest mark of any season in program history, and shot 38.4 percent from three-point range, which ranks eighth all-time.

Pergola is currently averaging 12.9 points per game and 3.3 assists, both ranking her within the top-15 in the NE10.

Pergola set a career-high with 24 points, as well as six three-pointers made, against the College of Staten Island, last week.

Her previous career-high was 20 points, last vs. Goldey-Beacom on Jan. 1, 2020. Her high in three-pointers was four, last accompolished at Chestnut Hill on Dec. 11, 2019.

She tallied her fifth game with 10 or more points on Sunday against the Saint Thomas Aquinas Spartans, leading the team with 18 points while going 3-6 from three.

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

The Chargers started the season off by holding the Bloomfield Bears to only 37 points, two short of their season-low in the 2019-20 season.

2021-22 GAME NOTES

On Nov. 28, the Chargers held the Spartans to 43 points, second lowest allowed after Bloomfield.

New Haven has held their opponents to 35.5 percent shooting on the season, which ranks third in the NE10. The Chargers also only allow a conference sixth best, 31.4 percent shooting from the perimeter.

The five starters have combined for 43 steals and and 18 blocks so far this season.

The Chargers are 2-0 when holding opponents to less than 50 points and are 4-0 when finishing with a better field goal percentage.

The squad also placed third in turnovers forced with an average of 19.0 per game.

BEYOND THE ARC

Junior Marigona Bacaliu connected on a threepointer against Bloomfield in week one, to score her first career points as a member of the Chargers.

The Chargers shot a season best 9-30 from three in the 72-64 overtime win over the College of Staten Island, laregly led by Brie Pergola's career-high game.

Gabrielle Stickle and Brianna Diaz both connected on three-pointers for their first of the season, against Pace on Nov. 24.

The Chargers hit back-to-back three-pointers twice in the second half of the Dec. 1 loss to Southern Conn. State.

TIS' THE SEASON OF GIVING

New Haven has dished out 69 assists to start the season. Leading the campaign is graduate student Brie Pergola who is tied for ninth in the NE10 with an average of 3.3 assists and tied for fifth with a season total of 23. The team itself is currently ranked 13th with 9.9 assists per game.

STORIED HISTORY

The women's basketball program at New Haven has a very strong history. The Chargers brought home the 1987 national championship title when they defeated Cal-Poly Pomona, 77-75, to lift the trophy. Overall, New Haven has advanced to the national tournament nine times, most recently in back-to-back seasons in 2014 and 2015. The latter of those two seasons saw the Chargers advance to the Elite Eight for just the second time in program history after defeating Stonehill 58-57 to win the East Region Championship.

NE10 TOURNAMENT HISTORY

New Haven qualified last season for the quarterfinals for the seventh time in 11 years since joining the NE10 prior to the 2008-09 season.

The Chargers hold a 4-4 record all-time in the NE10 quarterfinals, and won in two straight trips to the

EBBIE BUFF

HEAD COACH SECOND SEASON CORTLAND

Debbie Buff enter her third season at the helm of the Blue and Gold in 2021-22, coming to New Haven prior to the 2018-19 campaign following a seven-year stint at Wheeling Jesuit University (Wheeling, W.V.) which included back-toback Mountain East Conference Championships and NCAA Division II tournament appearances.

In her first two seasons, Buff (36-21) has led the Chargers to back-to-back 18 win campaigns and an appearance in the Northeast-10 Conference tournament in each of her first two seasons. During her second season in 2019-20, Buff led the Chargers to an 18-9 record. New Haven finished the season ninth in the nation in Division II in scoring defense, holding opponents to just 53.7 points per game. NE10 All-Rookie selection Aurora Deshaies led the conference in field goal pct. (.565), senior Micah Wormack earned Second Team All-NE10 honors, and Camryn DeBose was named to the Northeast-10 All-Academic Team.

In her first campaign with the Chargers in 2018-19, Buff led New Haven to an 18-12 record, an improvement of six wins over the season prior to her arrival. The season culminated with a trip to the NE10 semifinals for the first time since 2016 following a road victory over Stonehill in the NE10 quarterfinals. Buff also helped mentor Alexandria Kerr, a First Team All-NE10 honoree and three-time CoSIDA First Team Academic All-District selection.

Prior to New Haven, Buff took over the Wheeling Jesuit program in 2011 and in five years led her first full recruiting class to the first of back-to-back Mountain East Conference Championships in 2015-16. The Cardinals finished that season with a 27-6 overall record, which tied the school record for most victories in a single season.

The Cardinals followed that up with a second-straight 25win season, Mountain East Championship and subsequent trip to the NCAA Division II regional championship. Over her seven years in West Virginia, Buff collected a 111-93 overall record for a .544 winning percentage. Over her seven years, the Cardinals finished with a plus-.500 record on four occasions.

Prior to Wheeling Jesuit, Buff spent two seasons at Endicott College where she led the Gulls to the most wins in school history with a 23-6 record in 2008-09 and an appearance in the championship game of the Commonwealth Coast Conference. In her two seasons at Endicott, she compiled an overall record of 42-14.

Her first stint as a head coach came at the Rochester Institute of Technology where her five-plus year career was highlighted by Empire 8 Coach of the Year accolades in 2006-07 when she led the Tigers to the most victories in the history of the RIT women's basketball program and the program's first ever appearance in the Empire 8 and ECAC Championships.

Prior to her collegiate head coaching career, Buff served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at fellow Northeast-10 opponent College of Saint Rose where she helped lead the Golden Knights to the 2000 NCAA Division II Northeast Region Championship, a 34-1 record and a national ranking as high as No. 1 in the country.

Previous to joining a college program, Buff spent 14 years as the head coach at Bishop Maginn High School in Albany. In her time there, she recorded 203 wins and 57 losses while capturing five Big 10 Conference Championships, a Section II title, a regional title and a New York State Class A title. A Hall of Famer at Bishop Maginn, Buff was named the New York State Coach of the Year following the team's 1996 state title run.

A graduate from the State University of New York College at Cortland with a Bachelor of Science degree in physical education, she also holds a Master's Degree in health education from Russell Sage College. During her time at Cortland, she competed three years for the women's basketball team before turning her attention to training for the Skylon International Marathon in New York. In addition to Skylon, Buff has competed in seven triathlons, most notably the Lake Placid Olympic Tour triathlon.

Outside of her coaching and triathlon experiences, Buff has donated countless hours of volunteer time with the Alzheimer's Association and the Make A Wish foundation, both causes near and dear to her heart.


