## THE FIRST LOOK

After a home win over AIC to open North-east-10 Conference play, the Chargers head on the road for their first league game away from home as they meet Bentley in a re-match of last season's NE10 Championship deciding contest. The Chargers and Falcons met twice last season with the first securing the first NE10 Championship since 2012 and the second in the opening round of the NCAA Division II Championship. Both games came on the Blue & Gold Turf of DellaCamera Stadium

## INSIDE THE SERIES

- New Haven and Bentley meet for the 14th time in the history of the two programs.
- The Chargers hold a 10-3 record in the previous 13 meetings, all since football returned to West Haven in 2009.
- Prior to an overtime loss in 2017, the Blue and Gold had won seven straight, with the lone loss in the initial match-up in 2009, a 25-18 decision in West Haven.

- All but six of the games between New Haven and Bentley has been decided by one possession or less, including a 22-21 nail biter in 2015 with Danny Stock cementing the victory with a 34-yard FG with two seconds remaining in regulation.

## A WIN OVER BENTLEY WOULD...

- be the third straight win against Bentley following two against the Falcons last season.
- be the 15th straight win against a team from the NE10, dating back to an Oct. 12, 2019 loss to Saint Anselm on the road
- keep Bentley winless in NE10 play as they will open conference action this weekend
- be the 269th overall victory in the 43 plus year history of Charger Football.
- be the 239th victory since the Chargers began playing at the Division II level - first DII season was 1982.

## BY THE NUMBERS

**1** Record to fall so far in the 2022 season as graduate transfer wide receiver Terrell Ford broke a single-game record with his 229 return yards against AIC. Included in Ford's record return game was an 81-yard touchdown return, the first since the 2015 season for New Haven.

**2** the number of sellouts at DellaCamera Stadium so far in 2022 with 3,578 fans for the home opener vs SCSU and 4,017 for the NE10 opener against AIC.

**2** the number of players to earn NE10 weekly awards following the first week of NE10 play - quarterback Connor Degenhardt and special teams returner Terrell Ford.

**5** touchdowns by quarterback Connor Degenhardt against AIC in the NE10 opener, the most he has thrown since joining the Blue and Gold prior to the 2021 season.

**44** Years of football at the University of New Haven. The inaugural season was in 1973.

### GAME DAY FORECAST

New Haven and Bentley will meet under fall like temperatures with the high for the day at just 58 degrees and the Friday night low at 43 degrees. There is a 2% chance of precipitation and a 59% humidity level. Winds on Friday night will be around 17 miles per hour out of the northwest. Sunset is set for 6:40 p.m. while the moon is set to rise at 3:51 a.m.

### SCOUTING THE CHARGERS

New Haven enters the rematch of last season's NE10 Championship splitting its offense rather evenly between the running and passing game. For the year, New Haven is averaging 123.3 yards on the ground and 239 yards in the air. Among the highlights in the ground game has been sophomore Christopher Ais who leads the team with 209 net yards and a pair of touchdowns. His 69.7 yards per game average is currently tied for the most in the NE10. Graduate quarterback Connor Degenhardt found his rhythm last weekend against AIC, throwing five touchdowns, the most for a Charger QB since the 2019 season. For the year, he has completed 50-of-92 passes for 717 yards. Degenhardt has a number of options to rely on in the passing game as he has relied on 13 different Chargers, with his top target being graduate student Chris Carlyle who returned in 2022 after suffering a season-ending injury prior to the start of the 2021 season. Defensively, New Haven is led by graduate student Damon Burton, Jr., who has 22 total tackles, two TFL, a sack, an interception, three breakups and a forced fumble. Combined, the Chargers have 21 tackles for loss and 10 sacks which puts them as one of the best defenses in the NE10. As a unit, New Haven has limited opponents to just 65.7 rushing yards per game, including a season-low three years allowed to AIC last weekend. The 65.7 yards is the lowest in the NE10 and is the 12th lowest in the nation.

### SCOUTING THE FALCONS

Bentley will open its NE10 schedule on Friday night against the Chargers, entering the game with a 2-1 overall record with the wins the last two times out against Pace and Post. Through the first three games, Bentley has split its 404 yards per game average nearly down the middle between the passing and running

game. On the ground, the Falcons sport two of the top-five leading rushers on the season, including quarterback Mark Waid who is currently tied for the team lead with the Chargers starting RB Christopher Ais. Following him for the Falcons is senior Nate Larkins who is averaging 69.3 yards per game and leads the team with five touchdowns, four rushing and one receiving. In the air, Waid has completed 52.5 percent of his passes for an average of 179 yards per game. Defensively, the Falcons are led by junior linebacker Salvatore Lupoli, Jr. who also leads all NE10 players with an average of 10.3 tackles per game.

### NEXT ON TAP

New Haven will remain on the road for its next game when they travel to currently unbeaten Saint Anselm on Saturday, October 1. Kickoff in the NE10 battle against the Hawks scheduled for 3:00 p.m. Fans unable to make the game can catch all the action live on NE10 NOW.

### DOUBLE TEAM

Following the Chargers NE10 opening win over American International, a pair of Chargers double teamed the weekly conference awards with quarterback Connor Degenhardt earning Offensive Player of the Week and wide receiver Terrell Ford named Special Teams Player of the Week. Ford's award comes fresh off of setting a single game school record for the most kickoff return yards (229) in a single game, including returning one 81 yards for a touchdown. In addition to his work on special teams, Ford also finished the day with three receptions for 53 yards and a touchdown, his first for the Blue and Gold as a receiver. Degenhardt led New Haven's offense with 247 passing yards and five touchdowns, the most in a single game since 2019. Overall, Degenhardt completed 19-of-32 pass attempts, while he also collected 18 net yards on the ground, including a 22-yard run on fourth down conversion.

### WE'VE GOT EYES ON YOU

Heading into the 2022 season, a pair of Chargers are already in the spotlight with quarterback Connor Degenhardt and defensive back Khyon Fitzpatrick among the 475 players listed on the College Gridiron Small College Showcase Watch List, putting them square in the eyes of

scouts across the country. The Watch List is composed by a panel of college and pro football experts and will be updated throughout the 2022 season.

DIAMOND IN THE ROUGH

A third Chargers is also among those who scouts will have their eye on throughout the year as defensive back Devonte Myles made his way on to the NFL Draft Diamond watch list over the summer. Myles certainly put-up numbers last year that should turn some heads and will continue to do the same damage this season. In 2021, Myles finished with 58 tackles, an interception, a fumble recovery and seven pass breakups.

DYNAMIC DUOS

The 2022 football roster includes two sets of siblings, including a pair of twin brothers, all of which will have an impact throughout the season. The twins come in the form of Christian and Christopher Ais, both of which are among the starting 11 on offense and defense. Christopher is the Chargers starting running back, who last week led the Blue and Gold carrying the ball 20 times for 17 yards. Christian is a starting defensive back who finished his rookie season with nine tackles and a pair of interceptions. The other pair of siblings on the roster hail from West Haven - Jake and Zack Conlan. Both Conlan brothers find themselves on the offensive side of the ball with Jake a running back and Zack a wide receiver. Last week, Jake carried the ball three times, while last season he finished with 688 yards and five touchdowns. Zack will see the majority of his time on special teams while also seeing a limited number of snaps as a wide out.

ONE DEGREE ISN'T ENOUGH

With a master's program in sport management, an MBA program and a renowned school of criminal justice

it is no wonder so many students call New Haven home when it comes to postgraduate degrees. This season is no different, and for the second year in a row the Chargers have the most graduate students on the active roster in all of Division II. With 28 grad students on the opening day roster, the Chargers also have the most among all teams at all divisions, with Nebraska next in line with 26 grads in their program. According to the annual update from the National Football Foundation, 3,067 student-athletes across all divisions will be competing after having received an undergraduate degree. Of that total, 262 players from 31 Division II schools are among those pursuing graduate degrees.

State, the New Haven football team entered the year ranked among the Top-25 teams in the country in three different coaches' polls. Highlighting those preseason rankings was the American Football Coaches Association poll which had the Chargers ranked 16th in the country. The first poll to be released was the College Football America yearbook which had the Blue and Gold 14th, while D2Football.com listed the Chargers 18th. Heading into week three against American International, the Chargers remain among the Top-25 in the AFCA Coaches poll, ranked 23rd.

## LEAVE IT ALL ON THE LINE

Over the last handful of years, the Chargers offensive line has always been the biggest challenge for opponents' defensive strategies and 2022 will be no different. Last season, the Chargers O-Line helped lead the offense to an average of 346 total yards per game and a 30.3 points per game average which led all Northeast-10 teams. Additionally, the O-Line held strong, limiting opponents defense to just 14 sacks allowed, while also leaving passing lanes wide open to the point of opponents picking off just four passes all season, which was sixth best in all of NCAA Division II.

## LEADERSHIP TRIO

Following the Chargers three-week preseason, head coach Chris Pincince announced a trio of players that will make up the leadership corps for 2022; quarterback Connor Degenhardt, defensive back Khyon Fitzpatrick and offensive lineman Will Ayers. All three played incredibly important roles last season and will be looked on to continue that success while also leading the next generation of Chargers to a repeat NE10 Championship and a deep run into the postseason.

## WHAT D2FOOTBALL.COM IS PREDICTING FOR WEEK 4 (PAUL FALEWICZ - NE10 WEEKLY UPDATE)

Friday Night game. New Haven defeated American International 54-26 last Saturday. The Chargers pulled away in the second half as the offense clicked all day and the defense played better as the game went along. They have won 14 straight league games and are ready for the challenge. For New Haven to win in front of 423 people at Bentley, the offense will need to move the ball and score in the red zone. The defense will need to pressure the quarterback and dominate the line of scrimmage. Bentley took care of business in their 49-6 victory over Post last Friday night. # GAME 4: NEW HAVEN AT BENTLEY

## THE SCHEDULE

The New Haven football team will play five home games as part of a 10-game schedule in 2022. The lone game against a non NE10 team comes in week one when the Chargers will travel to Bowie, Md. for a battle of two ranked teams. A second non-conference game will come in week two when the Blue and Gold host crosstown rival Southern Connecticut for the first of two meetings against the Owls. Week three will kick off an eight-game NE10 schedule that features four games at home and four on the road. The regular season finale will come in the form of the annual Battle of the Elm City as the Chargers and Owls will meet for round two. NCAA postseason play kicks off on November 19 with the top seven teams in Super Region 1 battling for a spot in the national semifinals.

## PRESEASON PROPS

Returning to the field for the first time after winning the 2021 Northeast-10 Conference Championship, going undefeated in league play, the University of New Haven football team will enter the 2022 season as the preseason favorite to win the Northeast-10 Conference championship in a poll of the league's eight head coaches. New Haven racked up a total of 49 points and seven of the eight possible first place votes in the poll, finishing 12 points ahead of the Assumption Greyhounds who garnered the only other first place vote.

# GAME 4: NEW HAVEN AT BENTLEY



## CHRIS PINCINCE HEAD COACH EIGHTH SEASON BOSTON UNIVERSITY '94

The 2021 Northeast-10 Conference Coach of the year, Chris Pincince was named the 10th head coach at the University of New Haven in February 2014, bringing more than 20 years of collegiate coaching experience to the sidelines, including many at the

NCAA Division I level.

In seven seasons leading the Chargers, Pincince has collected 52 wins passing Mark Whipple as the all-time winningest coach in the storied history of the program, while leading the Blue and Gold to the NCAA Championship Second Round in each of the last two appearances in the national playoffs (2018 & 2021).

Overall in seven seasons, 12 players have received All-American accolades while offensive lineman Zach Voytek was a three-time NE10 Offensive Lineman of the Year and signed as an undrafted free agent with the Buffalo Bills. Additionally, 59 different players have been named All-Conference, while 12 have garnered All-Region honors.

This past season, the Chargers finished the year 10-2 overall, including an undefeated 8-0 record in Northeast-10 Conference play, earning the program's eighth trip to the NCAA Division II Championship. The Blue and Gold went on to defeat Bentley in the opening round to advance to the regional semifinals for the second time in as many appearances. In addition to Pincince earning NE10 Coach of the Year accolades, he was also named the New England Football Writers Coach of the Year while graduate offensive lineman Mike Zecchin joined him with a major award as he was tabbed the NE10's Offensive Lineman of the Year.

After finishing among the best defensive programs in the country, the Chargers were highlighted by junior defensive back Khyon Fitzpatrick who was named a second team All-American by the American Football Coaches of America. Overall, Fitzpatrick and Zecchin were part of 14 players who earned NE10 All-Conference honors while as a team, the Chargers finished 2021 ranked No.14 in the AFCA Coaches Poll.

After missing the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 shutdown, the Chargers closed out the 2019 season finished tied with Bentley with a 6-2 record in Northeast-10 Conference play. Among the highlights for Pincince's squad was Shamar Logan garnering NE10 Rookie of the Year accolades as he was one of 16 Chargers to earn NE10 postseason distinction. Logan would go on to earn All-Region honors along with Markel Johnson and Ju'an Williams, the latter of which was named the regions Special Teams Player of the Year.

In 2018, Pincince coached a pair of record breakers in quarterback AJee Patterson and Williams. Patterson graduated as arguably the best quarterback in New Haven history, the first to throw for more than 10,000 yards while racking up 80 touchdowns, second most in program history. The NE10 MVP and First Team All-Conference selection, Patterson closed out his collegiate campaign with a career-high 2,878 yards and 29 touchdowns, leading his squad to the NCAA Championship for the first time since 2012. Williams, a Don Hanson Honorable Mention All-American, registered a single season school record 1,171 receiving yards which came on 65 catches while completing 11 for touchdowns. Joining Williams in earning All-American accolades was Dan Iannone who anchored an offensive line that contributed to 4,827 total yards on offense, the most in the NE10, which included just shy of 2,000 yards rushing. In addition, the O-Line protection was impeccable, allowing Patterson to be sacked just three times through the 10-game regular season.

Voytek was one of two Chargers named All-American in 2016, joining linebacker Tyler Condit. Together, the pair were part of nine total players who received NE10 All-Conference honors following a 7-4 season that included a pair of wins over crosstown rival Southern Connecticut State University, representing eight straight season New Haven has maintained the Elm City Trophy. On the field, Condit set a pair of records, becoming the all-time leading tackler at New Haven as well as in the Northeast-10. He finished his collegiate career with 117 tackles as a senior, becoming just the second player in school history to finish with at least 100 stops in three seasons.

In just his second season leading the Chargers, Pincince led the Blue and Gold to the N10 Championship game, finishing the year with a 7-4 record. Among the highlights were a pair of record setting performances from

junior running back Andre Anderson and Condit. Anderson broke a 22 year old record set by Roger Graham when he rushed for 319 yards in the regular season finale against Saint Anselm. In that same game, Condit shattered a 29 year old record when he finished with 25 tackles, giving him 153 for the season, which surpassed the previous record of 134 by Erik Lesinski. Anderson and Condit were two of four Chargers who received NE10 Player of the Year accolades at their respective positions, with Anderson earning Most Valuable Player accolades.

In his first season strolling the sideline at New Haven, Pincince led the Chargers to a 6-5 overall record, including a string of six straight victories in Northeast-10 Conference action. Among the highlights from Pincince's first season was Condit who was named a USA College Football All-America Honorable Mention. A pair of Chargers were also honored among the major awards from the Northeast-10 Conference with Voytek named co-Offensive Lineman of the Year and freshman running back Lemar Thomas named Rookie of the Year. In total, 10 players were named to NE10 All-Conference squads.

With two previous stints as an assistant at New Haven, Pincince began his career with the Chargers in 1995 as an assistant for UNH Athletics Hall of Famer and NFL Head Coach of the Miami Dolphins and Oakland Raiders (Interim) Tony Sparano (1961-2018). He spent three additional seasons with the Chargers from 1999 to 2001 under Darren Rizzi, current Assistant Head Coach and Special Teams Coordinator for the New Orleans Saints.

Prior to his most recent position as offensive coordinator at NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) member Elon University in North Carolina, Pincince was the offensive coordinator at the University of Rhode Island and the College of the Holy Cross.

At Elon, Pincince was the offensive coordinator as well as the quarterbacks and running backs coach for three seasons. In his first year Elon's offense led the Southern Conference and ranked 14th nationally with 281 passing yards per game. Pincince's offensive scheme was anchored by All-America wide receiver Aaron Mellette, who led all of FCS in receptions per game (10.27) and receiving yards per game (149). His season totals also set new school and conference records in 2011. Quarterback Thomas Wilson also led the conference and ranked 14th nationally in total offense. In his second season at Elon, the offense ranked 12th in the FCS in passing yards per game (296), with Mellette again earning All-America honors. The receiver became the first Elon player invited to the Senior Bowl and was later selected in the seventh round of the NFL draft by the Baltimore Ravens. In Pincince's final season at Elon, the Phoenix ranked second in the conference in passing yards per game (231) and averaged over 350 total yards per contest.

During the three seasons prior to arriving at Elon, Pincince was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at the University of Rhode Island. While at URI, Pincince installed the spread offense, and the Rams ranked fifth in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) in passing offense in his first season. Pincince also spent four years at the College of the Holy Cross, including two seasons as the Crusaders' offensive coordinator. In 2007, the Holy Cross offense led the Patriot League in scoring (35.9 ppg), passing (335 ypg), total offense (463 ypg) and first downs (272). Crusaders quarterback Dominic Randolph led the league in passing (3,604 yards), touchdown passes (30) and total offense (340 ypg) and finished 12th in the balloting for the Walter Payton Award. Pincince's first two seasons at Holy Cross were spent as the wide receivers coach.

Prior to his tenure at Holy Cross, Pincince served as the offensive coordinator at Ursinus College in 2003. The season before, Pincince was the quarterbacks coach at Brown University. He also spent two seasons at Fairfield University. During his five previous seasons at New Haven, the Chargers combined for a 32-18-1 record and advanced to the NCAA Division II quarterfinal round in 1995. The Chargers finished the regular season undefeated and earned a 27-12 victory over Edinboro in the opening round of the NCAA playoffs. In his second stint, the Chargers averaged over 30 points and 350 yards per game during his three-season stretch.

A native of Woonsocket, R.I., Pincince earned his bachelor's degree from Boston University in 1994. He was a member of the Terriers' 1993 Yankee Conference Championship team and played on two NCAA Division I-AA (now FCS) playoff teams. He and his wife, Jennifer, have two sons, Zachary and Owen, and a daughter, Emma.
