THE FIRST LOOK

After a bye week last weekend, the Chargers return to action with the homestretch in sight as they head to Assumption for a critical Northeast-10 match-up with the Greyhounds. The only undefeated team in the NE10, New Haven heads to Worcester to face the one-loss Greyhounds with that lone NE10 loss against Bentley.

INSIDE THE SERIES

- New Haven and Assumption meet for the 16th time in the history of the two programs, which dates back to the Chargers first year in the NE10, 2009.
- Despite an overall record that stands in favor of the Greyhounds (8-7) New Haven has won the last three straight meetings against Assumption.
- Prior to the current UNH streak of wins, Assumption had won six straight against the Chargers, including a 17-14 decision in the Northeast-10 Conference Championship game in 2015.
- Included in the series is three-straight

years where the teams met twice, 2013, 2014 and 2015.

A WIN OVER ASSUMPTION WOULD ...

- be the fourth straight against the Greyhounds, with the last three coming once in each of the last three seasons
- be the seventh straight win for the Chargers, including non-conference wins over SCSU and post and NE10 wins over AIC, Bentley, Saint Anselm and Pace.
- be the 272nd overall victory in the 43 plus year history of Charger Football.
- be the 242nd victory since the Chargers began playing at the Division II level - first DII season was 1982.

It will be a mirror image of the last time the Chargers took the field when they do so on Saturday in Worcester as the forecast calls for some clouds in the morning giving way to mostly sunny skies for the afternoon with a high around 60 degrees. The Saturday night

low is 38 degrees. There is a 6% chance of precipitation and a 56% humidity level. Winds on Saturday will be around five miles per hour out of the north-northeast. Sunrise on Saturday is set for 7:16 a.m. while sunset will be at 5:44 p.m.

SCOUTING THE CHARGERS

Despite an offensive explosion in the week prior to the bye week with 10 touchdowns against Post, the Chargers have been primarily a defensive driven team in Northeast-10 Conference play. In the three conference games ahead of the Post match-up, the Chargers forces six turnovers - three interceptions and three fumbles. Add to that four more against Post and New Haven's defense is certainly a tough match-up. All combined over those four games, New Haven has scored 34 points off of those turnovers. Overall, for the season, Onyemem leads the Blue and Gold with 49 tackles, including 6.5 tackles for loss and a pair of fumble recoveries that he has returned for 105 combined yards. He has also forced two fumbles and has broken up three passes. Offensively, it has been sophomore running back Christopher Ais who has put up three 100+ yard games this season, including back-to-back career high afternoons on the road at Bentley and Saint Anselm. For the season, Ais leads all NE10 running back with an average of 99.3 yards per game which ranks 26th in all of NCAA Division II, while his 695 rushing yards is the 39th most in the nation. The man marshaling all of that offense for the Chargers is graduate quarterback Connor Degenhardt who enters the weekend against Post with 1,311 passing yards and 17 touchdowns, while adding three more touchdowns in the ground game.

SCOUTING THE GREYHOUNDS

After suffering their first conference loss in a close, low scoring, battle against Bentley, the Greyhounds responded with a 24-7 road win against American International last weekend. For the season, the Greyhounds offense has been evenly split as they average 173.3 rushing yards per game and 144.0 passing yards per contest. Leading the Greyhounds offense on both ends has been senior quarterback Jack Cady who is responsible for nine of the teams 15 touchdowns. He leads Assumption in the running game

with 421 net yards on 82 attempts with a team-high five TD's. Under center, he has completed 106-of-208 passes for 1,008 yards and four touchdowns. Following him in the running game is Berrell Neal who has 416 yards and four touchdowns. Defensively, Assumption is led by Lorenzo Valencia who has 39 tackles, while Jael Feliz and Brandon Santell follow with 37 and 32 tackles, respectively. The pair also each have 6.5 tackles for loss, part of 45 total for the Greyhounds.

NEXT ON TAP

It will be a busy Saturday in West Haven when the Chargers next take the field on Saturday, November 5 for Homecoming in Charger Nation. In addition, the Blue and Gold are also hosting Senior Day with 21 Chargers being honored prior to the 1:00 p.m. kickoff against the Franklin Pierce Ravens. Fans who are unable to attend the game can catch all of the action live on the Charger Sports Network, part of NE10 NOW.

RUNNING AWAY WITH IT

Sophomore running back Christopher Ais has been a challenge to deal with for all of the Chargers opponents in 2022 and it will be no different this week against Pace. The speedy Ais currently leads all Northeast-10 running backs and is 28th in the nation with his average of 96.2 yards per game, boosted this past week with a 40-yard touchdown that came on the opening drive of the game. In addition to his speed, defenses also have to deal with his hurdling skills, as twice this year he has lept over the defense to extend his runs. For the season, Ais has 577 net yards, averaging 5.1 per carry with a long on the year of 73 yards which came against on the opening play of the game against Saint Anselm in Week 5. Ais also has half of the Chargers 10 rushing TD's to his credit.

RINSE & REPEAT

It's like deja vu as SO RB Christopher Ais was named the Northeast-10 Conference Offensive Player of the Week for the second straight week on October 3. Ais is coming off of a second-straight week with a career-high rushing performance, this time with 183 net yards, opening up the game with a 73-yard sprint to the house on the very first play of the afternoon as he found a hole in

the middle of the line and broke free down the right side. Overall, he would carry the ball 21 times and lost just three yards total on the day. The game-opening touchdown was his first of two on the afternoon, the second being a receiving score as he hauled in pass for a 13-yard touchdown, his only reception of the afternoon.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

For the second-straight week, a pair of Chargers have doubled up the weekly conference awards with running back Christopher earning Offensive Player of the Week and defensive back David Onyemem named Defensive Player of the Week in the final awards for the month of September. Onyemem's award comes fresh off of his fourth quarter scoop and score where he sprinted 34 yards to the house to give the Chargers an eight point lead. He also added eight tackles, including one TFL, against the Falcons. Ais led the New Haven offense with a career-high 131 yards on 26 carries. The sophomore running back opened up his day with a hurdle that led to a 42-yard gain on the opening drive against the Falcons, setting up his one and only touchdown of the day which came a couple plays later as he went up the middle for the 10-yd TD.

DOUBLE TEAM

Following the Chargers NE10 opening win over American International, a pair of Chargers double teamed the weekly conference awards with quarterback Connor Degenhardt earning Offensive Player of the Week and wide receiver Terrell Ford named Special Teams Player of the Week. Ford's award comes fresh off of setting a single game school record for the most kickoff return yards (229) in a single game, including returning one 81 yards for a touchdown. In addition to his work on special teams, Ford also finished the day with three receptions for

53 yards and a touchdown, his first for the Blue and Gold as a receiver. Degenhardt led New Haven's offense with 247 passing yards and five touchdowns, the most in a single game since 2019. Overall, Degenhardt completed 19-of-32 pass attempts, while he also collected 18 net yards on the ground, including a 22-yard run on fourth down conversion.

WE'VE GOT EYES ON YOU

Heading into the 2022 season, a pair of Chargers are already in the spotlight with quarterback Connor Degenhardt and defensive back Khyon Fitzpatrick among the 475 players listed on the College Gridiron Small College Showcase Watch List, putting them square in the eyes of scouts across the country. The Watch List is composed by a panel of college and pro football experts and will be

updated throughout the 2022 season.

DIAMOND IN THE ROUGH

A third Chargers is also among those who scouts will have their eye on throughout the year as defensive back Devonte Myles made his way on to the NFL Draft Diamond watch list over the summer. Myles certainly put-up numbers last year that should turn some heads and will continue to do the same damage this season. In 2021, Myles finished with 58 tackles, an interception, a fumble recovery and seven pass breakups.

DYNAMIC DUOS

The 2022 football roster includes two sets of siblings, including a pair of twin brothers, all of which will have an impact throughout the season. The twins come in the form of Christian and Christopher Ais, both of which are among the starting 11 on offense and defense. Christopher is the Chargers starting running back, who last week led the Blue and Gold carrying the ball 20 times for 17 yards. Christian is a starting defensive back who finished his rookie season with nine tackles and a pair of interceptions. The other pair of siblings on the roster hail from West Haven - Jake and Zack Conlan. Both Conlan brothers find themselves on the offensive side of the ball with Jake a running back and Zack a wide receiver. Last week, Jake carried the ball three times, while last season he finished with 688 yards and five touchdowns. Zack will see the majority of his time on special teams while also seeing a limited number of snaps as a wide out.

ONE DEGREE ISN'T ENOUGH

With a master's program in sport management, an MBA program and a renowned school of criminal justice it is no wonder so many students call New Haven home when it comes to postgraduate degrees. This season is no different, and for the second year in a row the Chargers have the most graduate students on the active roster in all of Division II. With 28 grad students on the opening day roster, the Chargers also have the most among all teams at all divisions, with Nebraska next in line with 26 grads in their program. According to the annual update from the National Football Foundation, 3,067 student-athletes across all divisions will be competing after having received an undergraduate degree. Of that total, 262 players from 31 Division II schools are among those pursuing graduate degrees.

ON THE RADAR

Ahead of the 2022 season opener at Bowie State, the New Haven football team entered the year ranked among the Top-25 teams in the country in three different coaches' polls. Highlighting those preseason rankings was the American Football Coaches Association poll which had the Chargers ranked 16th in the country. The first poll to be released was the College Football America yearbook which had the Blue and Gold 14th, while D2Football.com listed the Chargers 18th. Head-

ing into week six against Pace, the Chargers are just outside of the Top-25 in the AFCA Coaches poll, receiving 39 votes.

LEAVE IT ALL ON THE LINE

Over the last handful of years, the Chargers offensive line has always been the biggest challenge for opponents' defensive strategies and 2022 will be no different. Last season, the Chargers O-Line helped lead the offense to an average of 346 total yards per game and a 30.3 points per game average which led all Northeast-10 teams. Additionally, the O-Line held strong, limiting opponents defense to just 14 sacks allowed, while also leaving passing lanes wide open to the point of opponents picking off just four passes all season, which was sixth best in all of NCAA Division II.

LEADERSHIP TRIO

Following the Chargers three-week pre-season, head coach Chris Pincince announced a trio of players that will make up the leadership corps for 2022; quarterback Connor Degenhardt, defensive back Khyon Fitzpatrick and offensive lineman Will Ayers. All three played incredibly important roles last season and will be looked on to continue that success while also leading the next generation of Chargers to a repeat NE10 Championship and a deep run into the postseason.

GAME 8: NEW HAVEN AT ASSUMPTION



CHRIS PINCINCE HEAD COACH EIGHTH SEASON BOSTON UNIVERSITY '94

The 2021 Northeast-10 Conference Coach of the year, Chris Pincince was named the 10th head coach at the University of New Haven in February 2014, bringing more than 20 years of collegiate coaching experience to the sidelines, including many at the

NCAA Division I level.

In seven seasons leading the Chargers, Pincince has collected 52 wins passing Mark Whipple as the all-time winningest coach in the storied history of the program, while leading the Blue and Gold to the NCAA Championship Second Round in each of the last two appearances in the national playoffs (2018 & 2021).

Overall in seven seasons, 12 players have received All-American accolades while offensive lineman Zach Voytek was a three-time NE10 Offensive Lineman of the Year and signed as an undrafted free agent with the Buffalo Bills. Additionally, 59 different players have been named All-Conference, while 12 have garnered All-Region honors.

This past season, the Chargers finished the year 10-2 overall, including an undefeated 8-0 record in Northeast-10 Conference play, earning the program's eighth trip to the NCAA Division II Championship. The Blue and Gold went on to defeat Bentley in the opening round to advance to the regional semifinals for the second time in as many appearances. In addition to Pincince earning NE10 Coach of the Year accolades, he was also named the New England Football Writers Coach of the Year while graduate offensive lineman Mike Zecchin joined him with a major award as he was tabbed the NE10's Offensive Lineman of the Year.

After finishing among the best defensive programs in the country, the Chargers were highlighted by junior defensive back Khyon Fitzpatrick who was named a second team All-American by the American Football Coaches of America. Overall, Fitzpatrick and Zecchin were part of 14 players who earned NE10 All-Conference honors while as a team, the Chargers finished 2021 ranked No.14 in the AFCA Coaches Poll.

After missing the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 shutdown, the Chargers closed out the 2019 season finished tied with Bentley with a 6-2 record in Northeast-10 Conference play. Among the highlights for Pincince's squad was Shamar Logan garnering NE10 Rookie of the Year accolades as he was one of 16 Chargers to earn NE10 postseason distinction. Logan would go on to earn All-Region honors along with Markel Johnson and Ju'an Williams, the latter of which was named the regions Special Teams Player of the Year.

In 2018, Pincince coached a pair of record breakers in quarterback AJee Patterson and Williams. Patterson graduated as arguably the best quarterback in New Haven history, the first to throw for more than 10,000 yards while racking up 80 touchdowns, second most in program history. The NE10 MVP and First Team All-Conference selection, Patterson closed out his collegiate campaign with a career-high 2,878 yards and 29 touchdowns, leading his squad to the NCAA Championship for the first time since 2012. Williams, a Don Hanson Honorable Mention All-American, registered a single season school record 1,171 receiving yards which came on 65 catches while completing 11 for touchdowns. Joining Williams in earning All-American accolades was Dan Iannone who anchored an offensive line that contributed to 4,827 total yards on offense, the most in the NE10, which included just shy of 2,000 yards rushing. In addition, the O-Line protection was impeccable, allowing Patterson to be sacked just three times through the 10-game regular season.

Voytek was one of two Chargers named All-American in 2016, joining linebacker Tyler Condit. Together, the pair were part of nine total players who received NE10 All-Conference honors following a 7-4 season that included a pair of wins over crosstown rival Southern Connecticut State University, representing eight straight season New Haven has maintained the Elm City Trophy. On the field, Condit set a pair of records, becoming the all-time leading tackler at New Haven as well as in the Northeast-10. He finished his collegiate career with 117 tackles as a senior, becoming just the second player in school history to finish with at least 100 stops in three seasons.

In just his second season leading the Chargers, Pincince led the Blue and Gold to the N10 Championship game, finishing the year with a 7-4 record. Among the highlights were a pair of record setting performances from

junior running back Andre Anderson and Condit. Anderson broke a 22 year old record set by Roger Graham when he rushed for 319 yards in the regular season finale against Saint Anselm. In that same game, Condit shattered a 29 year old record when he finished with 25 tackles, giving him 153 for the season, which surpassed the previous record of 134 by Erik Lesinski. Anderson and Condit were two of four Chargers who received NE10 Player of the Year accolades at their respective positions, with Anderson earning Most Valuable Player accolades.

In his first season strolling the sideline at New Haven, Pincince led the Chargers to a 6-5 overall record, including a string of six straight victories in Northeast-10 Conference action. Among the highlights from Pincince's first season was Condit who was named a USA College Football All-America Honorable Mention. A pair of Chargers were also honored among the major awards from the Northeast-10 Conference with Voytek named co-Offensive Lineman of the Year and freshman running back Lemar Thomas named Rookie of the Year. In total, 10 players were named to NE10 All-Conference squads.

With two previous stints as an assistant at New Haven, Pincince began his career with the Chargers in 1995 as an assistant for UNH Athletics Hall of Famer and NFL Head Coach for the Miami Dolphins and Oakland Raiders (Interim) Tony Sparano (1961-2018). He spent three additional seasons with the Chargers from 1999 to 2001 under Darren Rizzi, current Assistant Head Coach and Special Teams Coordinator for the New Orleans Saints.

Prior to his most recent position as offensive coordinator at NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) member Elon University in North Carolina, Pincince was the offensive coordinator at the University of Rhode Island and the College of the Holy Cross.

At Elon, Pincince was the offensive coordinator as well as the quarterbacks and running backs coach for three seasons. In his first year Elon's offense led the Southern Conference and ranked 14th nationally with 281 passing yards per game. Pincince's offensive scheme was anchored by All-America wide receiver Aaron Mellette, who led all of FCS in receptions per game (10.27) and receiving yards per game (149). His season totals also set new school and conference records in 2011. Quarterback Thomas Wilson also led the conference and ranked 14th nationally in total offense. In his second season at Elon, the offense ranked 12th in the FCS in passing yards per game (296), with Mellette again earning All-America honors. The receiver became the first Elon player invited to the Senior Bowl and was later selected in the seventh round of the NFL draft by the Baltimore Ravens. In Pincince's final season at Elon, the Phoenix ranked second in the conference in passing yards per game (231) and averaged over 350 total yards per contest.

During the three seasons prior to arriving at Elon, Pincince was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at the University of Rhode Island. While at URI, Pincince installed the spread offense, and the Rams ranked fifth in the Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) in passing offense in his first season. Pincince also spent four years at the College of the Holy Cross, including two seasons as the Crusaders' offensive coordinator. In 2007, the Holy Cross offense led the Patriot League in scoring (35.9 ppg), passing (335 ypg), total offense (463 ypg) and first downs (272). Crusaders quarterback Dominic Randolph led the league in passing (3,604 yards), touchdown passes (30) and total offense (340 ypg) and finished 12th in the balloting for the Walter Payton Award. Pincince's first two seasons at Holy Cross were spent as the wide receivers coach.

Prior to his tenure at Holy Cross, Pincince served as the offensive coordinator at Ursinus College in 2003. The season before, Pincince was the quarterbacks coach at Brown University. He also spent two seasons at Fairfield University. During his five previous seasons at New Haven, the Chargers combined for a 32-18-1 record and advanced to the NCAA Division II quarterfinal round in 1995. The Chargers finished the regular season undefeated and earned a 27-12 victory over Edinboro in the opening round of the NCAA playoffs. In his second stint, the Chargers averaged over 30 points and 350 yards per game during his three-season stretch.

A native of Woonsocket, R.I., Pincince earned his bachelor's degree from Boston University in 1994. He was a member of the Terriers' 1993 Yankee Conference Championship team and played on two NCAA Division I-AA (now FCS) playoff teams. He and his wife, Jennifer, have two sons, Zachary and Owen, and a daughter, Emma.
