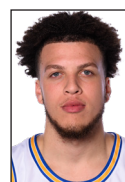

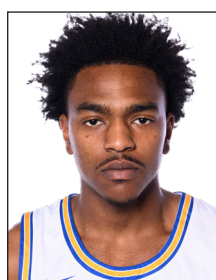

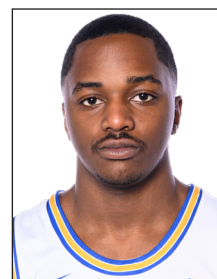

THE LEAD

The New Haven men's basketball team will look to bounce back after their season opener was spoiled by the Saint Michael's Purple Knights on Wednesday night. The 74-75 loss was the first season-opening loss since falling to No. 5 Saint Thomas Aquinas, 81-82 in overtime in 2017. The loss also broke a four-game win streak over the Purple Knights as the Chargers last lost to Saint Michael's during the 2016-17 season. However, home is where your heart is and the Chargers will return home for the first time this season as they host the Adelphi Panthers on Saturday afternoon. Last season, New Haven held a record of 10-3 when playing at Charger Gymnasium. Tipoff is scheduled for 3:30 P.M. on Saturday.

SCOUTING NEW HAVEN

In their first game of the 2022-23 season, the Chargers fell to the Saint Michael's Purple Knights, 74-75. Davontrey Thomas (Poughkeepsie, N.Y./Poughkeepsie), who led the team in points a season ago, tied a team-high with 20 points on 8-12 shooting (57.1 percent) with half of his makes coming from beyond the perimeter. Newly added guard Ty Perry (Boston, Mass./Brighton) has fit right in as he scored 20 points in his Chargers' debut, his most points in a game since his 2018-19 season at Fordham. Perry also pulled in a career-high nine rebounds as he helped the Chargers outrebound the Purple Knights, 39-26.

Graduate guard Quashawn Lane (Trenton, N.J./Trenton Catholic Academy) finished with ten points, eight assists and five rebounds while also recording

a block and a steal on defense. Senior center Majur Majak (Poughkeepsie, N.Y./) also racked up ten points on 5-7 shooting to go with seven rebounds. The big man currently ranks fifth in the conference with a 71.4 field goal percentage. On defense, the reigning NE10 Defensive Player of the Year swatted away two attempts while also coming away with two steals. Graduate guard Victor Olawoye (Elmont, N.Y./Elmont Memorial High School) went 4-6 from the field, falling just shy of double-digit points with nine points.

With the Chargers playing a short bench, just eight total players saw action, New Haven saw all but five of its 74 points come from the starting five. On the other side, Saint Michael's used a barrage of three pointers to secure its victory, finishing the night with 14 buckets from beyond the arc, more than inside the arc as they finished the night 26-of-59 overall.

In addition to outrebounding the Purple Knights, the Chargers also dominated the paint, outscoring Saint Michael's 44-22. New Haven is shooting 54.9 percent from the field, 35.7 percent from deep and 75 percent at the line.

SCOUTING ADELPHI

Despite falling to #6 Assumption in the first round of the NE10 Championship last season, the Panthers finished the 2021-22 season with a 17-10 record (11-7 in conference play). In a poll of all head coaches, the Adelphi University men's basketball team was selected to finish sixth in the Northeast-10 Conference Preseason Poll with 82 points.

Fast forward to the start of the season and the Panthers enter the matchup with a 2-1 record.

After starting the season with an exhibition game against St. John's, Adelphi split a two-game weekend last week in the ECC/NE10 Conference Challenge. The Panthers dropped the first game against Queens, 72-79, before picking up a 91-87 win over Molloy the following day. In their most recent outing, Adelphi defeated Bloomfield in a dominating 93-69 victory on Wednesday night.

In the 24 point game against Bloomfield, six Panthers reached double-digit points. Senior forward Aristotelis Sotiriou recorded an 11 point-11 rebound double-double, however, it was the freshman guard Dayshaun Walton who led the team with 16 points.

Through three games, Adelphi has scored an average of 85.3 points per game, second most in the Northeast-10. The Panthers are shooting 50 percent from the floor, 29.7 percent from beyond the arc, and 67.2 percent from the free-throw line. Adelphi also ranks third in assists per game with 15, as well as ninth in total rebounds, 36.

Sotiriou has led the team in scoring on the season with 17.7 points per game, which also ranks ninth among all scorers in the conference. The senior forward also ranks fourth in the Northeast-10 in rebounding with 8.3 boards on average. Fellow senior forward Andrew Delaney follows close behind him with 8.0 rebounds per game.

Graduate guard Ronnie Silva returned for another season after leading the team in scoring last season. Silva is currently averaging 14.3 points per game while also recording 2.3 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game, as well. Silva has attempted the most three-pointers on the Panthers, making five of his 24 shots, while sophomore guard Matthew Price has drained six of his 18 attempts. Freshman Mason Jackson also averages double-digit points, ranking third among team starters with 10.7 points per game.

SERIES HISTORY VS ADELPHI

The relationship between the Chargers and the Panthers dates back to the 1976-77 season in which they first met on February 15. In the inaugural matchup between the two schools the Chargers fell to the Panthers, 67-78. This Saturday will mark the 51st time the

two will meet as New Haven trails in the series 21-29, despite entering the matchup on a three-game win streak over the Panthers. Most recently, the Chargers triumphed over Adelphi back in January, winning by 17 points.

The New Haven men's basketball team will hit the road once again for a three-game road trip starting with the College of Saint Rose on Tuesday, Nov. 22. Tipoff is set for 7:30 P.M. at Daniel P. Nolan Gymnasium. Catch all the action on Charger Sports Network or follow along with live stats!

HOME IS WHERE YOUR HEART IS

In the 60-year history of New Haven men's basketball, the Chargers hold an overall record of 39-21 in home opening games. New Haven opened up its program winning the home-opener in each of the first nine years and also had a stretch of nine-straight wins during the 80's. In recent history, the Chargers are 6-5 under head coach Ted Hotaling, and won the last home opening game against Staten Island, 81-50, in 2021-22. Hotaling led the Chargers to a 10-3 record in the comforts of Charger Gymnasium last season and has had a winning record at home in every season since the 2015-16 season.

PRESEASON PROPS

Before even stepping foot on the court in 2022-23, the New Haven men's basketball team is already under the watchful eye of the East Region voters on the Division II SIDA poll. Heading into week one, New Haven was third in the regional poll, earning one of the six possible first place votes. The Chargers trailed Bentley and Pace in this first release of the poll which will be updated weekly throughout the regular season.

PRESEASON POLL

In a poll of the league's 13 head coaches, the New Haven men's basketball team was predicted to win the NE10 title in 2022-23, earning five of the 13 possible first place votes. This comes on the heels of closing out the 2021-22 season with an 18-9 record and earning a trip to the NCAA East Region Semi-final round.

UNDER YOUR WATCHFUL EYE

In addition to the regional poll listed above, the Chargers also garnered attention nationally, listed among those schools receiving votes in the first Top-25 coaches poll released by the National Association of Basketball Coaches. This poll, which is voted on by coaches representing each conference in NCAA Division II is also updated weekly.

FITTING RIGHT IN

After losing long-time Charger Derrick Rowland in the offseason, the Chargers were one man short in their starting five. Hotaling brought in senior guard Ty Perry to fill that gap in the lineup and the transfer made an immediate impact. After stints at Fordham and Buffalo, Perry now calls New Haven home. In his Chargers' debut, Perry tied a team-high with 20 points on 8-20 shooting while pulling in a career-high nine rebounds. His 20 points are the most points he's scored in a game since his 2018-19 season at Fordham. Perry was also a factor on defense, coming away with a career-high three steals on the opposite end.

MAJOR BLOCK PARTY

The Chargers' big man transformed the paint into a restricted area last season, swatting away a conference-high 85 shots on his way to NE10 Defensive Player of the Year. After setting the New Haven single-season record for blocked shots, Majak hasn't lost a step, tallying two blocks in the opener while also recording a pair of steals.

EFFICIENCY IS KEY

Despite the loss, the Chargers were efficient with the ball in their hands, shooting 30-60 from the floor for an even 50 percent. New Haven also attempted 14 three-pointers, draining five of them, to end with 35.7 percent. With one game in the books, the Chargers average 74 points per game while ranking fifth in the Northeast-10 in offensive efficiency.

DOMINATING THE PAINT

Led by newcomer Ty Perry, the Chargers out-rebounded the Purple Knights, 39-26. New Haven did a majority of their damage down low, outscoring their opponent, 44-22, in the paint. Perry is currently ranked third in the conference after his career-high nine boards on Wednesday while Majak follows close behind with a ninth-best 7.0 rebounds per game.

AT THE HELM

Head coach Ted Hotaling enters his 12th season strolling the sidelines alongside his Chargers. With 173 career victories, Ted Hotaling stands second among nine head coaches in the history of the New Haven men's basketball program and with 27 more

wins would become just the second coach in program history to win 200 career games. Named the ninth head coach in program history on March 31, 2010, Hotaling led the Chargers to back-to-back appearances in the Northeast-10 Conference Championship game, a pair of nine total appearances in the conference tournament under his tutelage. In addition, Hotaling's teams have earned four bids to the NCAA Division II National Tournament, the most recent coming in 2022.

BUILDING FOR THE FUTURE

If you haven't visited North Campus recently you haven't seen the construction taking place adjacent to Charger Gymnasium. The site is the future home of the Peterson Performance Center, a state of the art facility that will house strength and conditioning, sports medicine, a new football locker room and meeting space with the ability to be tailored for the many different needs of all 20 varsity Charger athletic teams. The entire facility will measure 7,000 square feet

and house 20 Olympic style weightlifting racks and a 60-yard turf agility and conditioning area. Construction is scheduled to be completed during the fall with the building opening for the Spring 2023 semester.

HEAD COACH
TWELFTH SEASON

With 173 career victories, Ted Hotaling stands second among nine head coaches in the history of the New Haven men's basketball program and with 27 more wins would become just the second coach in program history to win 200 career games. The 2022-23 season will mark his 12th season strolling the sidelines of Charger Gymnasium.

Named the ninth head coach in program history on March 31, 2010, Hotaling led the Chargers to back-to-back appearances in the Northeast-10 Conference Championship game, a pair of nine total appearances in the conference tournament under his tutelage. In addition, Hotaling's teams have earned four bids to the NCAA Division II National Tournament, the most recent coming in 2022.

Highlighting his 173 career victories was a 79-68 win over crosstown rival Southern Connecticut State University on February 15, 2016 which earned Hotaling his 100th career victory at the helm of the Blue and Gold, becoming the fourth coach at New Haven to reach the century mark. Three years later, to the day, Hotaling earned his 150th career victory when the Chargers posted a 72-61 home win over American International. Overall, Hotaling's .558 winning percentage ranks third in program history, while his record of 55-45 through his first 100 contests was the best since 1995.

Under his guidance, Hotaling has led a host of Chargers to postseason accolades and career records marks. Leading that list is Eric Anderson '15, a two-time All-American (2014, 2015), three-time Northeast-10 Defensive Player of the Year, two-time All-Region and four-time All-Conference performer. Anderson closed out his career at New Haven 14th all-time in scoring (1,551 points) while he also set a school record with 238 career blocks, passing Herb Watkins (191; 1984-88).

Anderson is one of 10 different players who all-totaled hauled in 17 All-Northeast-10 Conference honors under Hotaling. In addition, Hotaling's players have collected five major NE10 distinctions, and four different players have received All-Region honors during his tenure.

In the most recent season completed, Hotaling led the Chargers back to the NCAA Division II Championship for the fourth time in his tenure, advancing to the East Region semifinal round for the second time in as many appearances. Overall, New Haven closed out the 2021-22 season with an 18-9 overall record and a mark of 13-6 in the Northeast-10, finishing second in the Southwest Division.

Among the individual highlights for New Haven was Majur Majak who was named the NE10's Defensive Player of the Year while leading the team, the NE10 and all of NCAA Division II in blocks per game with an average of 3.1, as he closed out the season with a New Haven single season record of 85 blocks. In addition to Majak, point guard Quashawn Lane also earned a spot on the NE10 All-Conference Second Team.

In the Chargers return to the court following the COVID-19 pandemic shutdown, Hotaling led the Chargers to their second-straight appearance in the NE10 Championship game, wrapping up the 2019-20 campaign with a 15-15 record. As the fifth seed in the Southwest Division, the Chargers were road warriors throughout the tournament, with the highlight of the championship coming in the semifinals when New Haven outlasted Stonehill in an instant three overtime thriller 101-100.

The season prior (2018-19), the Chargers finished with a 21-10 record, their third 20+ win season under Hotaling, after earning an at-large bid to their eighth NCAA Tournament appearance. New Haven's postseason run came to an end against eventual regional champion Saint Anselm, but not before tying their highest win total under Hotaling which was previously set in 2013-14.

The 2017-18 season saw Hotaling lead the Chargers New Haven to the Northeast-10 Conference Championship for a second-straight season and the sixth time in program history. The Chargers earned a bye through the first round before falling to Merrimack in the quarterfinals. Overall, New Haven finished the 2017-18 season with a 17-10 record, the sixth time in the last seven years Hotaling has led New Haven to a winning season.

The Chargers made their fifth appearance in the NE10 Championship under Hotaling in the 2016-17 campaign, closing out the year 15-14 overall. New Haven earned a first round victory over Merrimack 84-58. During the 2015-16 season, Hotaling coached the Chargers to arguably the biggest win in program history when New Haven knocked off crosstown rival Southern Connecticut State. The Blue and Gold led the Owls for all but six minutes as they defeated the No. 2 ranked team, according to the NABC Coaches Poll, 79-66.

In 2014-15, Hotaling led the Chargers to their fourth-straight winning season, closing out the year with a 15-12 overall record. Among the highlights was senior Eric Anderson who was named Northeast-10 Defensive Player of the Year for a third-straight season, the first time in NE10 history a player has earned the top defensive accolades three years in a row. Anderson was also a repeat member of the NE10 All-Conference First Team and stands as the only Charger to earn first team honors. In addition, Anderson was named a Daktronics/Division II Conference Commissioners Association Third Team All-American and signed a contract to play with the Gladiators Trier in Germany's Basketball Bundesliga ProA League following the season.

Statistically, Anderson led NCAA Division II in rebounds per game (13.1) and defensive rebounds per game (9.85). He was also among the top-10 in the nation in double doubles (8th) and total rebounds (5th).

Hotaling's 2012-13 and 2013-14 teams finished with back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 2002-03 and 2003-04, while also earning back-to-back appearances in the NCAA postseason tournament. Hotaling's 21-9 record in 2013-14 stands as the most wins in a single season under his leadership, while the Chargers' 14-6 record in the NE-10 that season was the second-best since joining the conference in 2008-09. That squad led the nation in personal fouls per game (13.6), while the Chargers ranked second in Division II in fewest turnovers per game (8.9). New Haven also ranked in the top 10 nationally in scoring defense (6th) and field goal percentage defense (9th).

Individually, Hotaling mentored Anderson to NE10 Defensive Player of the Year and All-America Honorable mention recognition - the first such mention for New Haven in 24 years. Anderson finished his junior season leading the Northeast-10 Conference and second in Division II in defensive rebounds per game (8.97). He also ranked third in the nation with 20 double-doubles.

In 2012-13, Hotaling led the Chargers to a 20-9 record - their first 20-win campaign since 2003-04. New Haven reached the NCAA postseason for the first time since 2004 and earned its first win on the national stage since 2003 with a victory over Dominican in the NCAA Division II East Region Quarterfinals.

That season, Hotaling's Chargers led the NE10 and ranked 10th nationally in fewest turnovers committed per game (11.0) and slotted at 13th in the country in scoring defense with an NE10-leading 61.1 points per game allowed. New Haven also finished second in the conference and 38th in Division II in free throw percentage (74.3). Individually, Anderson earned his first NE10 Defensive Player of the Year honor, finishing second in the nation with 18 double-doubles while ranking third with 12.0 rebounds per game and ninth in blocked shots at 2.45 per game.

Hotaling led the Chargers to a 15-13 record in 2011-12 - a seven-win improvement from the previous campaign and the club's first winning season since 2004-05. New Haven also qualified for the Northeast-10 Conference Championship, winning a First Round contest at Pace before falling in a 54-51 heartbreaker at Adelphi in the Quarterfinals.

In his first season as head coach, the Chargers posted an 8-18 overall mark and a 6-16 record in the Northeast-10 Conference. Throughout the season, New Haven ranked among the top three-point shooting teams in Division II. Freshman Justin Exum concluded the season ranked 17th nationally in three-point field goals per game. He was also the highest ranked freshman in that category. As a team, UNH ranked 31st in three-point field goal percentage and 32nd in three-point field goals per game.

With over 15 years of college coaching experience, Hotaling most recently spent five seasons as an assistant at Eastern Kentucky University. While at EKU, the Colonels enjoyed a number of record-setting seasons, including two postseason runs. Hotaling's main responsibilities at EKU included working with the guards and coordinating the program's recruiting efforts.

In 2007, the Colonels earned a berth to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship tournament. EKU was selected to the College Basketball Invitational this season after amassing a 20-11 regular season record. The Colonels were one of the best offensive teams in the country during Hotaling's tenure as well. In 2010, EKU ranked in the top 10 in three-point field goals made, turnovers per game and assist/turnover ratio. The Colonels also broke the Ohio Valley Conference record for three-pointers made in back-to-back seasons (2008-09 and 2009-10).

Prior to arriving at Eastern Kentucky, Hotaling served four years as a full-time assistant at Yale University from 2001-05. He also served one season as an assistant at UNH in 2000-01. The Niverville, N.Y. native began his coaching career at Adelphi University in 1998 where he spent one season as an assistant.
