THE LEAD

The University of New Haven men’s basketball erased a nine point deficit in their last time on the court as they defeated the Saint Rose Golden Knights, 69-65, in overtime on Tuesday. Heading into Thanksgiving break, the Chargers own a 2-1 record while riding a two-game win streak. After winning their five of their last six games over the Golden Knights, New Haven will face an unfamiliar opponent as they head to Pennsylvania to take on the IUP Crimson Hawks for their first non-conference game. The Chargers look to continue their hot shooting, 52.9 percent from the field, that ranks them first in the Northeast-10 conference. Tip-off for the fourth game of the season is scheduled for 4:30 P.M. at the Kovalchick Convention and Athletic Complex on Saturday, Nov. 26.

SCOUTING THE CHARGERS

After a commanding 82-64 win over Adelphi at home on Saturday, the Chargers hit the road again for the start of a three-game road trip. Despite starting their latest game against Saint Rose on a 12-4 run, the Chargers fell behind by nine points in the second half. New Haven battled back from the deficit to take a three point lead with 18 seconds left in the game but Saint Rose’s Shane O’Dell drained a last second shot from beyond the arc to send the game to overtime. A Quashawn Lane (Trenton, N.J./Trenton Catholic Academy) layup with five seconds on the clock put the Chargers up by three but Victor Olawoye (Elmont, N.Y./Elmont Memorial High School) secured the win with a steal before making a free throw to put the game out of reach.

Through three games, the Chargers have taken advantage of opportunities on offense, shooting a conference-best 52.9 percent. With an average of 75 points per game, the offense ranks fourth in efficiency. Newcomer Ty Perry (Boston, Mass./Brighton) has made an immediate impact for New Haven, leading the team with 18.3 points per game after tying a career high with 22 points on Tuesday. Perry shot 8-11 in the first half after starting off a perfect 4-4. In addition to his hot start on offense, the transfer guard has been crashing the boards, recording 6.7 rebounds per game, second most on the team and 13th most in the conference.

Davontrey Thomas (Poughkeepsie, N.Y./Poughkeepsie), who scored 15 points his last time out, follows close behind Perry with an average of 18 points per game. Despite a season-low from Thomas, the junior forward has made 20 of his 32 shot attempts for a 62.5 field goal percentage. Thomas has been a consistent threat from deep, making 10-20 (50 percent) of his three-pointers on the season.

The duo of Lane and Olawoye has played a key role in the Charger’s offensive scheme as the pair averages 13.7 and 10.7, respectively. The two guards have combined for 32 rebounds, 16 a piece, and 26 assists to start the campaign. Perry, Thomas and Lane have all recorded three straight games with double-digit points.

Majur Majak (Poughkeepsie, N.Y./) pulled down aseason-high 10 rebounds in the win as he now leads



the Chargers with 7.7 boards per game. Although the senior big man only averages 8.0 points per game, Majak tops the NE10 leaderboard by shooting 73.3 percent from the floor. On defense, Perry has come away with seven steals while Majak continues to rack up blocks, leading the team and conference with 2.7 blocks per game.

For the first time this season, the Chargers were outrebounded by an opponent, 36-38, despite outscoring the Golden Knights in the paint, 42-32. In addition to a conference best 52.9 field goal percentage, the Chargers also are also shooting 29.4 percent from deep and 68.4 percent at the line.

SCOUTING THE CRIMSON HAWKS

For the third straight season the IUP men’s basketball team won the conference title last season, as the Crimson Hawks defeated Millersville 63-52 in the 2022 Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) tournament championship game. Under Head Coach Joe Lombardi, the Crimson Hawks recorded their most wins in a season since the 2009-10 season, as they finished with a 33-3 record and were ranked as high as #3/2 by the end of the year. IUP’s season didn’t just end with a PSAC championship title but the Crimson Hawks made an appearance in 2022 Division II Men’s Basketball Championship, making it all the way to the semifinals before falling to Augusta, 76-61.

IUP picked up where they left off as they enter this matchup ranked #3/2 with a 4-0 record, winning all four games by a double-digit margin. After starting the season with a pair of exhibition games against Syracuse and Miami (Fl.). The Crimson Hawks won their first two regular season games in the PSAC / MEC / CIAA Challenge where they defeated Concord, 77-60, before taking down Winston-Salem State, 67-50, on the following day.

IUP has only played one game at the Kovalchick Convention and Athletic Complex this season, besting the Bowie State Bulldogs, 76-55, on Nov. 16. Forward Tomiwa Sulaiman led the Crimson Hawks with a 16 point- 13 rebound double-double as the team racked up a season-high 41 rebounds. Despite season-lows in field goals and three-pointers, the Crimson Hawks sunk 22 free throws on 28 attempts as opposed to the Bulldogs, 6-7.

The Crimson Hawks are coming off a domi-

nant 74-60 win over #20/NR Walsh on Saturday, Nov. 19. After jumping out to a 31-11 lead towards the end of the opening half, IUP secured the victory by shooting 15-27 (55.56 percent) in the second half. A contributing factor to the early lead was the Crimson Hawks’ suffocating defense that held the Cavaliers to 6-24 shooting (25 percent) in the first half including 0-9 from the beyond the arc.

Graduate guard Shawndale Jones leads the team in scoring, racking up a conference third-best 21.8 points per game on 28-67 shooting (41.8 percent). Jones, who also averages 4.5 rebounds, is coming off a season-high 26 points in the win over Walsh.

With 15 assists on the year, redshirt senior guard Dave Morris, leads the team in passing. Morris has drained the most three-pointers on the team, making eight of his 30 attempts from the perimeter this season, as he averages 15.0 points per game. The Crimson Hawk with the best shooting percentage from distance has been junior forward Ethan Porterfield, who averages 12.5 points while going 6-17 (35.3 percent) from three. Both Morris and Portefield have tallied 4.5 boards on average but the latter leads the defense with six total blocks.

Sulaiman has recorded the most rebounds on the team, pulling down 28 rebounds including 10 on offensive possessions. His 7.0 rebounds per game ranks tied for 14th in the conference as the team itself has been outrebounded 145-156 on the year.

Through four games, IUP has scored an average of 73.5 points per game, ninth most in the PSAC, while holding opponents to a conference low of 56.3 points on average. The Crimson Hawks are shooting 46.1 percent from the floor, 32.2 percent from beyond the arc, and 80 percent from the free-throw line. As a squad, the Crimson Hawks average 36.3 rebounds while ranking fourth in assists per game with 16.0, as well as steals with 9.5 per game.

In 16 seasons, Lombardi has a 367-106 (.774) overall record with 11 NCAA tournament appearances, six PSAC tournament titles (2010, 2011, 2013, 2019, 2020, 2022), three Atlantic Region Championships (2010, 2015, 2022) and two Division II National Championship Game appearances (2010, 2015). He boasts a 224-56 (.800) record in conference games

In the 60-year history of New Haven men’s basketball, the team has never faced off with the Crimson Hawks of Indiana (Pa.) as this Saturday’s matchup will mark the first meeting between the two programs.

PRESEASON POLL

In a poll of the league’s 13 head coaches, the New Haven men’s basketball team was predicted to win the NE10 title in 2022-23, earning five of the 13 possible first place votes. This comes on the heels of closing out the 2021-22 season with an 18-9 record and earning a trip to the NCAA East Region Semi-final round.

After losing long-time Charger Derrick Rowland in the offseason, the Chargers were one man short in their starting five. Hotaling brought in senior guard Ty Perry to fill that gap in the lineup and the transfer made an immediate impact. After stints at Fordham and Buffalo, Perry now calls New Ha-

ven home. In his Chargers’ debut, Perry tied a team-high with 20 points on 8-20 shooting while pulling in a career-high nine rebounds. Perry was also a factor on defense, coming away with a career-high three steals on the opposite end. In the 69-65 OT win over Saint Rose, Perry tied a career-high 22 points on 10-18 shooting, starting off 8-11 in the first half. Perry is currently 3rd in the conference in points per game and 13th in total rebounds per game.

MAJUR BLOCK PARTY

The Chargers’ big man transformed the paint into a restricted area last season, swatting away a conference-high 85 shots on his way to NE10 Defensive Player of the Year. After setting the New Haven single-season record for blocked shots, Majak hasn’t lost a step, tallying eight blocks in the first three games while also recording four steals.

EFFICIENCY IS KEY

The Chargers have been efficient with the ball in their hands, shooting 92-174

(52.9 percent) from the floor, a conference best. Majak currently leads all conference scorers with a 73.3 shooting percentage, followed closely by Thomas, who is shooting 62.5 percent. With three game in the books, the Chargers average 75 points per game while ranking fifth in the Northeast-10 in offensive efficiency.

DOMINATING THE PAINT

For the first time this season, the Chargers were outrebounded by an opponent. Despite a season-high 10 rebounds from Majak, the Golden Knights outrebounded New Haven, 36-38. However, the Chargers still outscored Saint Rose in the paint, 42-32. Perry is currently ranked 13th in the conference after posting a career-high nine boards in game one while Majak leads the team with 7.7 rebounds per game, sixth in the NE-10. As a squad, the team ranks 2nd with 30.0 defensive rebounds per game and 8th in total rebounds with 36.0.

ing the second-least amount of points in the conference, holding opponents to 68 points per game. New Haven has also held opponents to a second-least 39.5 field goal percentage and a third-least 31.8 three-point percentage. Led by Perry, who is first in the NE-10 with 2.7 steals per game, New Haven ranks 7th in steals with an average of 7.3. Olawoye came up with a massive steal in the final seconds of overtime against Saint Rose to secure a victory for the Chargers.

SEASON OF GIVING

The Chargers racked up 16 assists for the second straight week in the winning effort over Adelphi on Nov. 22, led by Olawoye, who tallied eight. Olawoye dished out four assists in the first six minutes of play of that game. Despite only tallying 10 assists in the win over Saint Rose, the Chargers still rank 5th in the conference with 14 assists per game. Lane stands atop of the leaderboard with 5.0 assists per game while Olawoye fell to 5th with 3.7 per game.

AT THE HELM

Head coach Ted Hotaling enters his 12th season strolling the sidelines alongside his Chargers. With 175 career victories, Ted Hotaling stands second among nine head coaches in the history of the New Haven men's basketball program

and with 25 more wins would become just the second coach in program history to win 200 career games. Named the ninth head coach in program history on March 31, 2010, Hotaling led the Chargers to back-to-back appearances in the Northeast-10 Conference Championship game, a pair of nine total appearances in the conference tournament under his tutelage. In addition, Hotaling's teams have earned four bids to the NCAA Division II National Tournament, the most recent coming in 2022.

BUILDING FOR THE FUTURE

If you haven't visited North Campus recently you haven't seen the construction taking place adjacent to Charger Gymnasium. The site is the future home of the Peterson Performance Center, a state of the art facility that will house strength and conditioning, sports medicine, a new football locker room and meeting space with the ability to be tailored for the many different needs of all 20 varsity Charger athletic teams. The entire facility will measure 7,000 square feet and house 20 Olympic style weight-lifting racks and a 60-yard turf agility and conditioning area. Construction is scheduled to be completed during the fall with the building opening for the Spring 2023 semester.

TED HOTALING
 HEAD COACH
 TWELFTH SEASON
 ALBANY '95

With 173 career victories, Ted Hotaling stands second among nine head coaches in the history of the New Haven men's basketball program and with 27 more wins would become just the second coach in program history to win 200 career games. The 2022-23 season will mark his 12th season strolling the sidelines of Charger Gymnasium.

Named the ninth head coach in program history on March 31, 2010, Hotaling led the Chargers to back-to-back appearances in the Northeast-10 Conference Championship game, a pair of nine total appearances in the conference tournament under his tutelage. In addition, Hotaling's teams have earned four bids to the NCAA Division II National Tournament, the most recent coming in 2022.

Highlighting his 173 career victories was a 79-68 win over crosstown rival Southern Connecticut State University on February 15, 2016 which earned Hotaling his 100th career victory at the helm of the Blue and Gold, becoming the fourth coach at New Haven to reach the century mark. Three years later, to the day, Hotaling earned his 150th career victory when the Chargers posted a 72-61 home win over American International. Overall, Hotaling's .558 winning percentage ranks third in program history, while his record of 55-45 through his first 100 contests was the best since 1995.

Under his guidance, Hotaling has led a host of Chargers to postseason accolades and career records marks. Leading that list is Eric Anderson '15, a two-time All-American (2014, 2015), three-time Northeast-10 Defensive Player of the Year, two-time All-Region and four-time All-Conference performer. Anderson closed out his career at New Haven 14th all-time in scoring (1,551 points) while he also set a school record with 238 career blocks, passing Herb Watkins (191; 1984-88).

Anderson is one of 10 different players who all-totaled hauled in 17 All-Northeast-10 Conference honors under Hotaling. In addition, Hotaling's players have collected five major NE10 distinctions, and four different players have received All-Region honors during his tenure.

In the most recent season completed, Hotaling led the Chargers back to the NCAA Division II Championship for the fourth time in his tenure, advancing to the East Region semifinal round for the second time in as many appearances. Overall, New Haven closed out the 2021-22 season with an 18-9 overall record and a mark of 13-6 in the Northeast-10, finishing second in the Southwest Division.

Among the individual highlights for New Haven was Majur Majak who was named the NE10's Defensive Player of the Year while leading the team, the NE10 and all of NCAA Division II in blocks per game with an average of 3.1, as he closed out the season with a New Haven single season record of 85 blocks. In addition to Majak, point guard Quashawn Lane also earned a spot on the NE10 All-Conference Second Team.

In the Chargers return to the court following the COVID-19 pandemic shutdown, Hotaling led the Chargers to their second-straight appearance in the NE10 Championship game, wrapping up the 2019-20 campaign with a 15-15 record. As the fifth seed in the Southwest Division, the Chargers were road warriors throughout the tournament, with the highlight of the championship coming in the semifinals when New Haven outlasted Stonehill in an instant three overtime thriller 101-100.

The season prior (2018-19), the Chargers finished with a 21-10 record, their third 20+ win season under Hotaling, after earning an at-large bid to their eighth NCAA Tournament appearance. New Haven's postseason run came to an end against eventual regional champion Saint Anselm, but not before tying their highest win total under Hotaling which was previously set in 2013-14.

The 2017-18 season saw Hotaling lead the Chargers New Haven to the Northeast-10 Conference Championship for a second-straight season and the sixth time in program history. The Chargers earned a bye through the first round before falling to Merrimack in the quarterfinals. Overall, New Haven finished the 2017-18 season with a 17-10 record, the sixth time in the last seven years Hotaling has led New Haven to a winning season.

The Chargers made their fifth appearance in the NE10 Championship under Hotaling in the 2016-17 campaign, closing out the year 15-14 overall. New Haven earned a first round victory over Merrimack 84-58. During the 2015-16 season, Hotaling coached the Chargers to arguably the biggest win in program history when New Haven knocked off crosstown rival Southern Connecticut State. The Blue and Gold led the Owls for all but six minutes as they defeated the No. 2 ranked team, according to the NABC Coaches Poll, 79-66.

In 2014-15, Hotaling led the Chargers to their fourth-straight winning season, closing out the year with a 15-12 overall record. Among the highlights was senior Eric Anderson who was named Northeast-10 Defensive Player of the Year for a third-straight season, the first time in NE10 history a player has earned the top defensive accolades three years in a row. Anderson was also a repeat member of the NE10 All-Conference First Team and stands as the only Charger to earn first team honors. In addition, Anderson was named a Daktronics/Division II Conference Commissioners Association Third Team All-American and signed a contract to play with the Gladiators Trier in Germany's Basketball Bundesliga ProA League following the season.

Statistically, Anderson led NCAA Division II in rebounds per game (13.1) and defensive rebounds per game (9.85). He was also among the top-10 in the nation in double doubles (8th) and total rebounds (5th).

Hotaling's 2012-13 and 2013-14 teams finished with back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 2002-03 and 2003-04, while also earning back-to-back appearances in the NCAA postseason tournament. Hotaling's 21-9 record in 2013-14 stands as the most wins in a single season under his leadership, while the Chargers' 14-6 record in the NE-10 that season was the second-best since joining the conference in 2008-09. That squad led the nation in personal fouls per game (13.6), while the Chargers ranked second in Division II in fewest turnovers per game (8.9). New Haven also ranked in the top 10 nationally in scoring defense (6th) and field goal percentage defense (9th).

Individually, Hotaling mentored Anderson to NE10 Defensive Player of the Year and All-America Honorable mention recognition - the first such mention for New Haven in 24 years. Anderson finished his junior season leading the Northeast-10 Conference and second in Division II in defensive rebounds per game (8.97). He also ranked third in the nation with 20 double-doubles.

In 2012-13, Hotaling led the Chargers to a 20-9 record - their first 20-win campaign since 2003-04. New Haven reached the NCAA postseason for the first time since 2004 and earned its first win on the national stage since 2003 with a victory over Dominican in the NCAA Division II East Region Quarterfinals.

That season, Hotaling's Chargers led the NE10 and ranked 10th nationally in fewest turnovers committed per game (11.0) and slotted at 13th in the country in scoring defense with an NE10-leading 61.1 points per game allowed. New Haven also finished second in the conference and 38th in Division II in free throw percentage (74.3). Individually, Anderson earned his first NE10 Defensive Player of the Year honor, finishing second in the nation with 18 double-doubles while ranking third with 12.0 rebounds per game and ninth in blocked shots at 2.45 per game.

Hotaling led the Chargers to a 15-13 record in 2011-12 - a seven-win improvement from the previous campaign and the club's first winning season since 2004-05. New Haven also qualified for the Northeast-10 Conference Championship, winning a First Round contest at Pace before falling in a 54-51 heartbreaker at Adelphi in the Quarterfinals.

In his first season as head coach, the Chargers posted an 8-18 overall mark and a 6-16 record in the Northeast-10 Conference. Throughout the season, New Haven ranked among the top three-point shooting teams in Division II. Freshman Justin Exum concluded the season ranked 17th nationally in three-point field goals per game. He was also the highest ranked freshman in that category. As a team, UNH ranked 31st in three-point field goal percentage and 32nd in three-point field goals per game.

With over 15 years of college coaching experience, Hotaling most recently spent five seasons as an assistant at Eastern Kentucky University. While at EKU, the Colonels enjoyed a number of record-setting seasons, including two postseason runs. Hotaling's main responsibilities at EKU included working with the guards and coordinating the program's recruiting efforts.

In 2007, the Colonels earned a berth to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship tournament. EKU was selected to the College Basketball Invitational this season after amassing a 20-11 regular season record. The Colonels were one of the best offensive teams in the country during Hotaling's tenure as well. In 2010, EKU ranked in the top 10 in three-point field goals made, turnovers per game and assist/turnover ratio. The Colonels also broke the Ohio Valley Conference record for three-pointers made in back-to-back seasons (2008-09 and 2009-10).

Prior to arriving at Eastern Kentucky, Hotaling served four years as a full-time assistant at Yale University from 2001-05. He also served one season as an assistant at UNH in 2000-01. The Niverville, N.Y. native began his coaching career at Adelphi University in 1998 where he spent one season as an assistant.
